SUB:- ADVANCE RELEASE ON EXTERNAL TRADE STATISTICS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2014.

EXPORTS:

According to the provisional figures compiled by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, exports from Pakistan during May, 2014 amounted to Rs.208,737 million (provisional) as against Rs. 186,723 million (provisional) in April, 2014 and Rs.210,829 million during May, 2013 showing an increase of 11.79% over April,2014 but a decrease of 0.99% over May, 2013.

- 2. In terms of US dollars the exports in May, 2014 was \$ 2,117 million (provisional) as compared to \$ 1,915 million (provisional) in April, 2014 showing an increase of 10.55% but a decrease of 1.21% as compared to \$ 2,143 million in May, 2013.
- 3. Exports during July-May, 2013 2014 totalled Rs.2,386,715 million (provisional) as against Rs.2,152,151 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 10.90%.
- 4. In terms of US dollars the exports during July May, 2013 2014 totalled \$ 23,112 million (provisional) as against \$ 22,286 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 3.71%.
- 5. Main commodities of exports during May, 2014 were Cotton cloth (Rs.22,413 million), Knitwear (Rs.20,841 million), Bedwear (Rs.18,804 million), Readymade garments (Rs.18,761 million), Cotton yarn (Rs.14,325 million), Rice others (Rs.9,967 million), Towels (Rs.7,102 million), Made-up articles (excl. towels & bedwear) (Rs.6,619 million), Rice basmati (Rs. 6,108 million) and Leather tanned (Rs.5,922 million).

IMPORTS

- 7. Imports into Pakistan during May, 2014 amounted to Rs.362,365 million (provisional) as against Rs. 396,476 million (provisional) in April, 2014 and Rs.427,531 million during May, 2013 showing a decrease of 8.60% over April, 2014 and of 15.24% over May, 2013.
- 8. In terms of US dollars the imports in May, 2014 was \$ 3,675 million (provisional) as compared to \$ 4,067 million (provisional) in April, 2014 showing a decrease of 9.64 and by15.44% as compared to \$ 4,346 million in May, 2013.
- 9. Imports during July May, 2013-2014 totalled Rs.4,207,524 million (provisional) as against Rs.3,961,521 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 6.21%.
- 10. In terms of US dollars the imports during July May, 2013-2014 totalled \$40,777 million (provisional) as against \$41,011 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 0.57%.
- 11. Main commodities of imports during May, 2014 were Petroleum products (Rs.69,468 million), Petroleum crude (Rs.48,296 million), Plastic materials (Rs.15,441 million), Palm oil (Rs.14,011 million), Iron & steel (Rs.13,906 million), Power generating machinery (Rs.10,105 million) Electrical machinery & apparatus (Rs.9,762 million), Iron and Steel scrap (Rs.7,916 million), Other apparatus (Rs.7,061 million) and Textile machinery (Rs.5,644) million).
