EXPORTS:

According to the provisional figures compiled by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, exports from Pakistan during May, 2016 amounted to Rs.191,769 million (provisional) as against Rs. 180,203 million (provisional) in April, 2016 and Rs.198,390 million during May, 2015 showing an increase of 6.42% over April,2016 but a decrease of 3.34% over May, 2015.

2. In terms of US dollars the exports in May, 2016 was \$ 1,832 million (provisional) as compared to \$ 1,722 million (provisional) in April, 2016 showing an increase of 6.39% but decreased by 6.00% as compared to \$ 1,949 million in May, 2015.

3. Exports during July - May, 2015 - 2016 totalled Rs.1,995,799 million (provisional) as against Rs.2,213,444 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 9.83%.

4. In terms of US dollars the exports during July – May, 2015 - 2016 totalled \$ 19,151 million (provisional) against \$ 21,859 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 12.39%.

5. Main commodities of exports during May, 2016 were Knitwear (Rs.23,023 million), Readymade garments (Rs.20,433 million), Cotton cloth (Rs.19,491 million), Bedwear (Rs.19,124 million), Rice others (Rs.12,562 million), Cotton yarn (Rs.9,691 million), Towels (Rs.7,178 million), Madeup articles (excl. towels & bedwear) (Rs.5,794 million), Rice basmati (Rs.4,904 million) and Leather tanned (Rs.3,688 million).

IMPORTS

7. Imports into Pakistan during May, 2016 amounted to Rs.419.502 million (provisional) as against Rs. 402,625 million (provisional) in April, 2016 and Rs.379,074 million during May, 2015 showing an increase of 4.19% over April, 2016 and of 10.66% over May, 2015.

8. In terms of US dollars the imports in May, 2016 was \$ 4,008 million (provisional) as compared to \$ 3,846 million (provisional) in April, 2016 showing an increase of 4.21% and by 7.63% as compared to \$ 3,724 million in May, 2015.

9. Imports during July - May, 2015 - 2016 totalled Rs.4,200,019 million (provisional) as against Rs.4,199,592 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 0.01%.

10. In terms of US dollars the imports during July - May, 2015 - 2016 totalled \$ 40,299 million (provisional) as against \$ 41,458 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 2.80%.

11. Main commodities of imports during May, 2016 were Petroleum products (Rs.60,789 million), Palm oil (Rs.18,052 million), Plastic materials (Rs.17,512 million), Iron & steel (Rs.16,073 million), Electrical machinery & apparatus (Rs.14,796 million), Petroleum crude Rs.14,573 million), Aircrafts, ships and ships (Rs.13,596 million), Power generating machinery (Rs.12,396 million), Iron & steel scrap (Rs.11,949 million) and Medicinal products (Rs.8,485 million).
