Analysis of Consumer Price Index (CPI) Base Year (2015-16)

2. The CPI on new base (2015-16) comprises of urban CPI and Rural CPI. The Urban CPI covers 35 cities and 356 consumer items. The Rural CPI covers 27 Rural Centers and 244 consumer items. In the new base year (2015-16) National CPI for 12 major groups is also computed by taking weighted average of Urban CPI and Rural CPI.

MONTHLY ANALYSIS (M.o.M)

November, 2019 over October, 2019

CPI National with base year (2015-16) for the month of November, 2019 increased by 1.34% over October, 2019. The Urban CPI with base year (2015-16) recorded an increase of 1.00% while Rural CPI with base year (2015-16) recorded an increase of 1.86%. (Details are in the Monthly Review). CPI with old base year (2007-08) recorded an increase of 1.20%.
