Subject: Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) for the week ended on 27-06-2019.

The weekly SPI with base 2007-08=100 covering 17 urban centres and 53 essential items for all income groups/quintiles and combined has been computed.

11. A review of the current average prices of Cement collected for the week ended on 27.06.2019 shows an increase of 0.85% over previous week and an increase of 4.30% over corresponding week of the last year. Average retail prices of Fertilizers and Cement are given at Appendix-B.
