The production in Jul-May 2019-20 as compared to Jul-May 2018-19 has increased in Fertilizers and Paper \& Board while it has significantly decreased in respect of Textile, Food, Beverages \& Tobacco, Coke \& Petroleum Products, Pharmaceuticals, Automobiles, Iron \& Steel Products and Electronics.
