

The production in July-September 2020-21 as compared to July-September 2019-20 has increased in Textile, Food, Beverages & Tobacco, Coke & Petroleum Products, Pharmaceuticals, Chemicals, Non Metallic Mineral Products and Paper & Paperboard while it decreased in Automobiles, Iron & Steel Products, Electronics and Leather Products.
