2. Detail Description:

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics collects the retail and the wholesale prices and computes the Consumer Price Index (CPI), Wholesale Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis and Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis. In January, 2015 the CPI is increased by 0.08% while WPI and SPI are decreased by 1.03% and 0.87% respectively.

Main contributors to month-on-month and year-on-year are given below:

i) <u>Month-on-month</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous month i.e. January, 2015 overDecember, 2014 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Tomatoes (7.30%), Chicken (5.00%), Pulse Gram (3.96%), Eggs (3.92%), Besan (2.47%) and Pulse Moong (1.81%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Potatoes (25.37%), Cooking Oil (2.27%), Beans (2.17%), Rice (1.97%) and Sugar (1.53%).

<u>Non-food Items Increased</u>: Firewood Whole (2.99%), House Rent (1.99%) and Medical Tests (1.80%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Kerosene Oil (7.03%), Motor Fuel (4.01%) and Transport Services (1.56%).

Year-on-Year: Top few commodities which varied from previous year i.e. January 2014 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Pulse Moong (21.82%), Cigarettes (20.39%), Pulse Mash (18.21%), Fresh Fruits (13.02%), Pulse Masoor (11.54%), Condiments (11.53%), Pulse Gram (11.20%), Milk Powder (10.59%), Eggs (10.41%) and Honey (10.16%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Onions (34.17%) and Wheat (11.10%).

Non-food Items Increased: Motor Vehicle Tax (36.71%), Education (14.20%), Cotton Cloths (12.93%), Tailoring (10.98%), Marriage Hall Charges (10.90%) and Woolen Readymade Garments (10.75%).

Decreased: Kerosene Oil (23.77%) and Motor Fuel (18.79%).

Top few commodities which varied from previous year average i.e. July-January2013-14 are given below:-

<u>Increased:</u> Potatoes (48.95%), Motor Vehicle Tax (36.71%), Pulse Moong (22.34%), Cigarettes (21.97%), Pulse Mash (18.17%) and Education (14.96%).

Decreased: Tomatoes (32.73%), Onions (28.36%), Tea (15.51%), Kerosene Oil (9.25%) and Motor Fuel (6.03%).

3. Core inflation of CPI

i. Trimmed Core Inflation

During the month of January, 2015 over January, 2014, the trimmed core inflation has been observed as 4.8% while it was 8.2% during January, 2014 over January, 2013.

ii. Non-Food & Non-Energy Core Inflation

During the month of January, 2015 over January, 2014, the Non-food &Non-energy core inflation has been observed as 6.4%while it was 8.0% during January, 2014 over January, 2013.
