2. Detail Description:

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics collects the retail and the wholesale prices and computes the Consumer Price Index (CPI), Wholesale Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis and Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis. In April, 2016 the CPI increased by 1.55% and WPI by 1.30% while SPI decreased by 0.12% respectively.

Main contributors to month-on-month and year-on-year are given below:

i) <u>Month-on-month</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous month i.e. March, 2016 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Tomatoes (60.41%), Chicken (30.75), Fresh Vegetables (14.32%), Fresh Fruit (13.42%), Gram Whole (5.71%), Pulse Mash washed (3.65%), Pulse Gram (3.58%), Besan (2.95%).

Decreased: Eggs (6.58%), Onion (5.72%) and Wheat (4.31%).

Non-food Items Increased: Education (4.97%), Medical Equipments (2.34%), Cotton Cloth (2.11%), Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (2.05%), Sewing Needle (1.56%), Kerosene Oil (1.4%), Motor Fuel (1.33%) and House Rent (1.22%).

Decreased: Motor Vehicle Accessories (1.75%).

ii) <u>Year-on-Year:</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous year i.e. April 2015 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Pulse Gram (59.94%), Pulse Mash (56.19%), Besan (51.73%), Gram Whole (31.68%), Cigarettes (29.24%), Chicken (17.12%), Betel Leaves and Nuts (14.1%) Tea (13.47%), Sugar (10.38%) and Pulse Masoor (8.76%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Rice (12.75%), Onion (10.54%), Cooking Oil (10.09%), Eggs (10.01%), and Vegetable Ghee (4.29%).

Non-food Items Increased: Gas (9.92%), Tailoring (8.39%), Household Servants (7.8%), Construction Wage Rates (7.66%), Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (7.64%), Water Supply (7.46%), Readymade Garments (6.44%) and Cleaning & Laundry (6.16%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Motor Fuel (10.01%), Kerosene Oil (7.08%), Motor Vehicle Accessories (4.35%) and Transport Services (2.13%).

The Consumer Price Index of July-April, 2015-16 has increased by 2.79% over July-April, 2014-15 as per details given below:-

Top few commodities which varied from previous year average i.e. July-April, 2014-15 are given below:-

<u>Increased:</u> Pulse Gram (51.64%), Besan (45.58%), Pulse Mash (39.95%), Onion (36.83%), Tea (23.68%), Cigarettes (21.87%), Gram Whole (20.94%), Sewing Needle (9.48%), Sugar (9.43%), Betel Leaves and Nuts (9.15%).

<u>Decreased</u>: Potatoes (47.36%), Kerosene Oil (16.53%), Rice (14.27%), Cooking Oil (14.02%), Motor Fuel (13.61%), Vegetable Ghee (10.36%), Eggs (9.75%) and Transport Services (6.05%).

3. Core inflation of CPI

i. Trimmed Core Inflation

During the month of April, 2016 over April, 2015, the trimmed core inflation has been observed as 3.8% while it was 3.1% during April, 2015 over April, 2014.

ii. Non-Food & Non-Energy Core Inflation

During the month of April, 2016 over April, 2015, the Non-food & Non-energy core inflation has been observed as 4.4% while it was 5.4% during April, 2015 over April, 2014.
