2. Detail Description:

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics collects the retail and the wholesale prices and computes the Consumer Price Index (CPI), Wholesale Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis and Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis. In September, 2015 the CPI decreased by 0.10% while WPI decreased by 0.39% and SPI increased by 0.45% respectively.

Main contributors to month-on-month and year-on-year are given below:

i) <u>Month-on-month</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous month i.e .August, 2015 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Onions(25.18%), Pulse Mash (4.21%), Tea (4.08%), Potatoes (3.56%), Fresh Vegetables (1.95%), Betel Leaves & Nuts (1.92%), Gur (1.62%) and Pulse Gram (1.47%), Besan (1.35%) and Gram Whole (1.04%).

Decreased:Chicken (17.00%),Tomatoes (11.65%), Fresh Fruits (8.44%), Eggs (3.44%), Cooking Oil (2.59%), Rice (1.99%), Sugar (1.54%) and Vegetable Ghee (1.53%).

Non-food Items Increased: Gas (9.92%), Blades (1.33%), Cleaning & Laundry (1.12%) and Construction Wage Rates (1.07%).

Decreased:Kerosene Oil (3.91%) and Motor Fuel (3.76%).

ii) <u>Year-on-Year:</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous year i.e. September, 2014 are given below:-

Food Items Increased: Pulse Gram (48.98%), Besan (40.50%), Tea (25.01%), Onions (20.61%), Pulse Mash (19.66%), Cigarettes (16.18%) and Gram Whole (15.76%).

Decreased:Potatoes (60.03%), Tomatoes (22.99%), Cooking Oil (14.85%), Rice (12.94%), Chicken (12.07%), Vegetable Ghee (11.82%) and Eggs (11.63%).

<u>Non-food Items Increased:</u>Woolen Readymade Garments (10.18%) and Sewing Needle & Dry Cell (10.05%).

Decreased:Kerosene Oil (25.48%), Motor Fuel (22.27%) and Transport Services (14.23%).

Top few commodities which varied from previous year average i.e. July-September, 2014-15 are given below:-

Increased: Pulse Gram (44.62%), Besan (37.44%), Tea (20.13%), Pulse Mash (19.43%), and Cigarettes (16.49%).

<u>Decreased:</u> Potatoes (61.62%), Kerosene Oil (22.57%), Motor Fuel (20.26%) and Cooking Oil (13.20%).

3. Core inflation of CPI

i. Trimmed Core Inflation

During the month of September, 2015 over September, 2014, the trimmed core inflation has been observed as 2.8% while it was 7.1 during September, 2014 over September, 2013.

ii.Non-Food & Non-Energy Core Inflation

During the month of September, 2015 over September, 2014, the Non-food & Non-energy core inflation has been observed as 3.4% while it was 8.1% during September, 2014 over September, 2013.
