



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Call for Applications for Joint Japan World Bank Graduate Scholarships (JWBGSP) for Master Degrees - Application Period February 22 to April 12, 2018

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the 2018-Joint Japan World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program (JJWBGSP) call for applications will be opened from February 22 to April 12, 2018.

2. The JJWBGSP, administered by the World Bank and funded by the government of Japan, aims to support the development of human resources in developing countries. JJWBGSP is open to women and men having three years relevant professional experience (full time paid employment) and a history of supporting country's development efforts. As per criteria, the applicant should:

- Not hold dual citizenship of a developed country;
- Hold a Bachelor (or equivalent) degree earned at least 3 years prior to the application deadline date;
- Have 3 years or more of recent development-related experience after earning a Bachelor (or equivalent) degree;
- Not be a staff member (which includes consultants) or relative of a staff member of the World Bank Group.
- Be accepted unconditionally to enroll in the upcoming academic year in one of JJWBGSP preferred master programs by the Application Deadline date;
- Be proficient in spoken and written English.

3. The application guidelines, online application and a complete list of selection criteria will be available on the Scholarships Program website: www.worldbank.org/scholarships by February 21, 2018. Applicants are required to apply online for their preferred scholarship program by following the application guidelines/instructions.

4. The applicants will receive a scholarship in development studies to one of the JJWBGSP's preferred Masters Programs (complete list of programs is available at www.worldbank.org/scholarships). Scholarship includes tuition, basic medical insurance provided by the university, a monthly living stipend, round-trip airfare, and travel allowance.

5. It is requested that the program may kindly be circulated within the Ministry/Division and Departments so that interested officials, who fulfill the program eligible criteria, can formally apply for their preferred program online by following prescribed procedure/channel.
