TRADE SUMMARY<br>January-March, 2019

## EXPORTS

The total exports of Pakistan during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to Rs. 817,532.45 million showing an increase of 4.88\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by 20.95\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

In terms of US dollar the export during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to $\$ 5,889.98$ million showing an increase of 1.42\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 but decreased by 3.25\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

Export during Jul-Mar, 2019 totaled Rs. 2,263,698.77 million showing an increase of $23.10 \%$ over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, exports stand at \$17,071.14 million showing an increase of $0.04 \%$ over the corresponding period of last year.

## IMPORTS

The total imports of Pakistan during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to Rs. 1,766,437.84 million showing a decrease of 4.38\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 but increased by 2.13\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

In terms of US dollar the import during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to $\$ 12,727.05$ million showing a decrease of 7.69\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by 18.34\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

Import during Jul-Mar, 2019 totaled Rs. 5,371,143.34 million showing an increase of 12.63\% over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, exports stand at \$40,679.48 million showing a decrease of $8.13 \%$ over the corresponding period of last year.

## TOTAL TRADE

The total trade of Pakistan during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to Rs. 2,583,970.29 million showing a decrease of 1.63\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 but increased by 7.42\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

In terms of US dollar the total trade during Jan-Mar, 2019 amounted to $\$ 18,617.02$ million showing a decrease of 4.99\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by 14.10\% over Jan-Mar, 2018.

Total trade during Jul-Mar, 2019 totaled Rs. $7,643,842.11$ million showing an increase of $15.54 \%$ over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, total trade stands at \$ $57,750.63$ million showing a decrease of $5.86 \%$.

## BALANCE OF TRADE

Balance of trade in Jan-Mar, 2019 was unfavorable to Pakistan to the tune of 948,905.39 million in rupees equal to US $\$ 6,837.07$ million, whereas during the period of July-Mar, 2019 it was unfavorable to the tune of $3,107,444.57$ million rupees equal to US $\$ 23,608.34$ million.

## I- EXPORT BY GROUP/COMMODITIES

## Food Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 export of goods belonging to Food Group increased by 26.92\% over Oct-Dec,2018 and by $21.77 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. Food Group contributed $17.16 \%$ of total exports.

The export of food group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $23.24 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Textile Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 export of Textile goods increased by $2.89 \%$ over Oct-Dec,2018 and by $25.45 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. Textile Group contributed $55.07 \%$ of total exports.

The export of textile group increased by $23.38 \%$ for the period of Jul-Mar, 2019 compared to the same period of last year.

## Manufactures Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 export of manufactured goods decreased by $9.42 \%$ over Oct-Dec,2018 but increased by $1.46 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. Manufactures Group contributed $7.01 \%$ of total exports.

Export for manufacturer group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $13.44 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## II- DIRECTION OF EXPORTS

During the month of Jan-Mar, 2019, the share of European Union in total exports was $33.66 \%$ as against $32.53 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of Other Asia during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $29.40 \%$ as against $29.36 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2019. The share of North America during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $17.88 \%$ as against $16.04 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of Middle East during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $9.20 \%$ as against $10.11 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of Other Africa during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $5.23 \%$ as against $6.83 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. Country-wise U. S. A. was at the top of the export list for Jan-Mar, 2019 followed by China, United Kingdom, Afghanistan, Germany, and Netherlands. The share of these six countries in total exports for Jan-Mar, 2019 was $48.05 \%$ as against $44.95 \%$ in JanMar, 2018.

During Jul-Mar, 2019 the share of European Union in total exports increased $34.11 \%$ from $33.98 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of Other Asia increased to $28.33 \%$ from $28.26 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of North America increased to $18.18 \%$ from $16.88 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of Middle East decreased to $9.18 \%$ from $9.70 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of Other Africa decreased to $5.39 \%$ from 6.39\% during the same period of last year.

Country-wise, U.S.A. was at the top of the exports list for Jul-Mar, 2019 followed by China, United Kingdom, Germany, Afghanistan and Netherlands. The share of these six countries in total exports for Jul-Mar, 2019 of the current financial year was $47.86 \%$ as against $46.63 \%$ in the same period of last year.

## III - EXPORT BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Export of Primary Commodities during Jan-Mar, 2019 increased by 18.96\%, SemiManufactures decreased by $5.07 \%$ and Manufactured Goods increased by $26.28 \%$. Whereas, their share in total export stands at 20.85\%, 9.46\% and 69.69\% consecutively.

Whereas the share of primary commodities in total export for the period of Jul-Mar, 2019 stood at $18.16 \%, 9.37 \%$ for semi-manufacturer and $72.46 \%$ for manufactured goods.

## I-IMPORT BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

## Food Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 import of goods belonging to Food Group increased by 1.84\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by 11.96\% over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed 6.24\% of total imports.

The import of food group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $12.32 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Machinery \& Transport Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 import of goods belonging to Machinery \& Transport group remain unchanged over Oct-Dec, 2018 but decreased by $16.47 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed 21.92\% of total imports.

The import of machinery \& transport group during Jul-Mar, 2019 decreased by 8.01\% compared to the same period of last year.

## Petroleum Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 import of goods belonging to Petroleum group decreased by 26.31\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by 1.96\% over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed 16.98\% of total imports.

The import of petroleum group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $16.74 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Textile Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 import of goods belonging to textile group increased by 13.75\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by $27.90 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed $2.53 \%$ of total imports.

The import of textile group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $27.10 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Chemical Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 import of goods belonging to Chemical group decreased by 8.58\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 but increased by 13.71\% over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed 15.72\% of total imports.

The import of chemical group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $24.67 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Metal Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 export of Metal products increased by 0.59\% over Oct-Dec, 2018 and by $0.15 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed $6.89 \%$ of total imports.

The import of metal group during Jul-Mar, 2019 increased by $12.62 \%$ compared to the same period of last year.

## Miscellaneous Group

During Jan-Mar, 2019 exports of miscellaneous commodities decreased by $3.34 \%$ over OctDec, 2018 but increased by 0.03\% over Jan-Mar, 2018. This group contributed $1.29 \%$ of total imports.

The import of miscellaneous group during Jul-Mar, 2019 decreased by 3.33\% compared to the same period of last year.

## II - DIRECTION OF IMPORTS

During the month of Jan-Mar, 2019, the share of Other Asia in total imports was $47.41 \%$ as against $48.67 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of Middle East during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $26.60 \%$ as against $25.58 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. European Union in total imports was $10.95 \%$ as against $10.83 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of North America during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $6.48 \%$ as against $6.63 \%$ in Jan-Mar, 2018. The share of Other Africa during Jan-Mar, 2019 was $5.64 \%$ as against $4.88 \%$ in JanMar, 2018. Country-wise China was at the top of the import list for Jan-Mar, 2019 followed by United Arab Emirates, U. S. A., Indonesia, Saudi Arabia and Qatar. The share of these six countries in total exports for Jan-Mar, 2019 was 56.29\% as against 54.90\% in Jan-Mar, 2018.

During Jul-Mar, 2019 the share of Other Asia in total import decreased to $45.42 \%$ from 48.48\% during the same period of last year. The share of Middle East increased to 29.65\% from $26.56 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of European Union in total import decreased to $10.34 \%$ from $10.97 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of North America decreased to $5.80 \%$ from $5.86 \%$ during the same period of last year. The share of Other Africa increased to 5.380\% from 4.06\% during the same period of last year.

Country-wise China was on the top of the imports list followed by United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, U.S.A., Indonesia and Qatar during Jul-Mar, 2019. The combined share of these six countries in total imports during this period was $56.96 \%$ as against their combined share of $55.97 \%$ during the corresponding period of last year.

## III - IMPORTS BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Imports of Consumer Goods during Jan-Mar, 2019 increased by 14.83\%, Raw Material for Consumer Goods by 4.98\%, Capital Goods decreased by $12.32 \%$ and Raw Material for Capital Goods increased by $18.81 \%$ over Jan-Mar, 2018. Their respective share in total imports were $17.43 \%$, 43.35\%, 28.23\% and 10.99\% respectively for Jan-Mar, 2018.

Meanwhile, the share of consumer goods for the period of Jul-Mar, 2019 stood at $18.13 \%$, raw material of consumer goods at $44.00 \%$, Capital goods at $27.38 \%$ and raw material for capital goods at 10.50\%.
