**SENSITIVE PRICE INDICATOR (SPI) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 12.03.2020.**  
**(To gauge inflation on weekly / short term basis)**

Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) is computed on weekly basis to assess the price movements of essential commodities at shorter interval of time so as to review the price situation in the country. SPI comprises of 51 essential items and the prices are being collected from 50 markets in 17 cities of the country.

**I. ANALYSIS OF WEEKLY SPI**

- ❖ The SPI for the current week ended on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 recorded **an increase** of **0.71%** over last week. This increase is mainly due to a surge in prices of **food items** i.e. Chicken (13.83%), Potatoes (12.72%), Eggs (8.19%), Onions (3.27%), Curd (1.40%), Wheat Flour (1.20%), Mutton (0.77%), Milk fresh (0.71%), Beef (0.35%) and among **non-food items** Long Cloth (1.49%) and Shirting (0.84%) with joint impact of 0.88 into the overall SPI for combined group of (0.71%).
- ❖ On the other hand, a decrease was observed in the prices of Tomatoes (4.32%), LPG (2.82%), Garlic (2.23%), Pulse Masoor (1.15%), Mustard oil (0.56%), Gur (0.36%), Pulse Mash (0.28%), Bananas (0.15%) and Firewood (0.03%).
- ❖ During the week, out of 51 items, prices of 14 (27.45%) items increased, 09 (17.64%) items decreased and 28 (54.90%) items remained constant.

**II.** The year on year trend depicts an **increase of 12.40%** with most of the items increased mainly Potatoes (133.82%), Garlic (100.74%), Onions (92.55%), Pulse Moong (72.47%), Pulse Mash (48.00%), Cigarettes (36.81%), Veg Ghee 1Kg (35.94%), Veg.Ghee 2.5kg (33.07%), Long Cloth (32.89%), Sugar (31.53%), Gur (30.58%), Cooking Oil 5kg (27.17%), Lawn Printed (24.63%), Petrol (19.98%), Pulse Gram (19.48%), Shirting (19.33%), Cooked Beef (18.54%), LPG (17.67%), Pulse Masoor (17.15%), Tea Prepared (16.68%), Mustard Oil (16.06%) and Powdered Milk Nido (15.31%). While a major decrease was observed in the price of Tomatoes (72.12%), Electricity (13.15%) and Eggs (1.03%).

**III. Current week over previous week (WoW) (12.03.2020 over 05.03.2020) showing 0.71% change.**
