SENSITIVE PRICE INDICATOR (SPI) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 07.05.2020.
(To gauge inflation on weekly / short term basis)

Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) is computed on weekly basis to assess the price movements of essential commodities at shorter interval of time so as to review the price situation in the country. SPI comprises of 51 essential items and the prices are being collected from 50 markets in 17 cities of the country.

I. ANALYSIS OF WEEKLY SPI

- ❖ The SPI for the current week ended on 7th May, 2020 recorded **an increase of 0.36%** over last week. This increase is mainly due to a rise in prices of **food items** i.e. Chicken (23.68%), Bananas (7.40%), Potatoes (5.14%), Gur (1.26%) and Chillies Powder (1.08%) and **non-food items** i.e. LPG (3.85%) and Long Cloth (1.24%) with joint impact of 1.33 into the overall SPI for combined group of (0.36%).
- ❖ On the other hand, a **decrease** was observed in the prices of Hi-Speed Diesel (25.20%), Petrol (15.55%), Onions (9.17%), Tomatoes (3.11%), Pulse Masoor (2.65%), Pulse Gram (1.43%), Garlic (1.22%), Curd (0.99%), Wheat Flour (0.49%), Sugar (0.12%), Mustard Oil (0.06%) and Veg. Ghee 1kg (0.02%).
- ❖ During the week, out of 51 items, prices of **16** (31.37%) items increased, **12** (23.52%) items decreased and **23** (45.09%) items remained constant.

II. The **year on year** trend depicts an **increase of 8.56%** with most of the items increased mainly Potatoes (121.36%), Pulse Moong (86.61%), Pulse Mash (55.27%), Pulse Masoor (40.86%), Cigarette (30.64%), Garlic (29.82%), Gur (28.89%), Veg Ghee 1Kg (28.53%), Veg. Ghee 2.5kg (27.41%), Pulse Gram (21.71%), Cooking Oil 5kg (20.92%), Sugar (19.79%), Bread Plain (19.69%), Sufi Washing Soap (18.18%) and Long Cloth (17.37%). While a major **decrease** was observed in the price of Tomatoes (51.66%), Hi-Speed Diesel (34.23%), Petrol (24.26%), Onions (23.11%), Bananas (1.51%) and Electricity for Q1 (0.27%).

III. Current week over previous week (WoW) (07.05.2020 over 30.04.2020) showing 0.36% change.
