Review of Foreign Trade July, 2016

EXPORTS

The total exports of Pakistan during July, 2016 amounted to Rs. 154,462.95 million as against Rs. 172,176.34 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 161,533.48 million during July, 2016 showing a decrease of 10.29% over June, 2016 and 4.38% over July, 2015.

In terms of U.S dollars, the exports during July, 2016 amounted to \$1,474.74 million as against \$1,646.26 million in June, 2016 and \$1,588.03 million during July, 2015 showing a decrease of 10.42% over June, 2016 and by 7.13% over July, 2015.

IMPORTS

The total Imports of Pakistan during July, 2016 amounted to Rs. 370,368.82 million as against Rs. 464,126.83 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 340,518.82 million during July, 2015 showing a decrease of 20.20% over June, 2016 while increased by 8.77% over July, 2016.

In terms of US dollars the imports during July, 2016 amounted to \$3,536.12 million as against \$4,437.74 million in June, 2016 and \$3,347.63 million during July, 2015 showing a decrease of 20.32% over June, 2016 but increased by 5.63% over July, 2015.

Based on the above figures of exports & imports the Balance of Trade in July, 2016 was unfavourable for Pakistan to the tune of 215,905.87 million rupees equal to US \$2,061.38 million.

I - Exports by Group/Commodities

Exports from Pakistan during July, 2016 amounted to Rs. 154,462.95 million as against the exports of Rs. 172,176.34 million in previous month and Rs. 161,533.48 million during the corresponding month of last year showing a decrease of 10.29% over previous month and by 4.38% over the corresponding month of last year.

Comparative figure of exports by group/commodities during July, 2016 compared to June, 2016 and July, 2015 are given in table-1.

Primary Commodities

During July, 2016 these 6 selected commodities of Primary Commodities contributed 9.00% of total exports in which the share of Rice was (5.69%), Fruits, vegetables & preparation thereof (2.31%) and Fish & fish preparation (0.75%).

Textile Manufactures

During July, 2016 these 9 selected commodities of Textile Manufactures contributed 63.90% of total exports in which the share of knitwear (13.95%), articles of apparel & clothing accessories (excl. knitwear) (11.96%), cotton fabrics (11.77%), bed wear (11.49%), and cotton yarn (6.95%).

Other Manufactures


During July, 2016 these 7 selected commodities of Other Manufactures contributed 9.30% of total exports in which the share of leather clothes & accessories (2.78%), leather (1.75%), Sports goods (excl. toys) (1.66%), surgical instruments (1.57%) and footwear (0.68%).

II – Analysis of Selected Commodities of Exports Cotton Fabrics

Cotton fabrics come up to third position in its group during July, 2016 from fourth in the previous month. During this month its exports amounted to Rs. 18,186.68 million as against Rs. 15,485.62 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 17,163.67 million during July, 2015 showing an increase of 17.44% over June, 2016 and by 5.96% over July, 2015.

During July, 2016 of current financial year 169,324 thousand sq. meters of cotton fabrics valued at Rs. 18,186.68 million were exported as against 147,432 thousand sq. meters valued at Rs. 17,163.67 million during the same period of last year showing an increase of 14.85% in terms of quantity and 5.96% in terms of value. During July, 2016 the average unit price of cotton fabrics decreased to Rs. 107.41 per sq. meter from Rs. 116.42 per sq. meter during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 7.74%.

Main buyers of cotton fabrics during July, 2016 of current financial year were Bangladesh (Rs. 3,231.97 million), China (Rs. 1,686.27 million), Germany (Rs.1,129.59 million), Turkey (Rs. 834.41 million), United Kingdom (Rs. 751.84 million), Netherlands (Rs. 732.03 million), U. S. A. (Rs. 710.30 million), Italy (Rs. 699.50 million), Sri Lanka (Rs. 589.36 million) and Mexico (Rs. 438.28 million). Their total take-off accounted for 59.45% of total exports of cotton cloth as compared to their combined share of 61.07% during the same period of last year.

Variety-wise exports of cotton fabrics during July, 2016 of current financial year and the corresponding period of last year are given below.

Cotton Yarn

Cotton yarn maintained its fifth position in its group during July, 2016 as in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 10,742.58 million as against Rs. 9,195.53 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 12,164.31 million in July, 2015 showing an increase of 16.82% over June, 2016 but decreased by 11.69% over July, 2015.

During July, 2016 exports of cotton yarn amounted to Rs. 10,742.58 million as against Rs. 12,164.31 million in the corresponding period of last year showing a fall of 11.69%. In terms of quantity 36,324 thousand kg of cotton yarn was exported during July, 2016 of current financial year as against 38,761 thousand kg during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 6.29%. The average unit price of cotton yarn for the period July, 2016 of current financial year was Rs. 295.74 per kg as against Rs. 313.83 per kg in the same period of last year showing an increase of 5.76%.

China (Rs. 8,119.45 million), Combodia (Rs. 7,218.85 million), Bangladesh (Rs. 850.44 million), Turkey (Rs. 504.97 million), Japan (Rs. 317.06 million), Hong Kong (Rs. 236.53 million), Korea Rep. of (Rs. 232.04 million), Portugal (Rs. 216.69 million), U.S.A.(Rs. 115.61 million), and Italy (Rs. 100.41 million), were major buyers of cotton yarn during this period. Their combined share accounted for 91.16% of total exports of cotton yarn as compared to their combined share of 91.58% during the same period of last year.

Variety-wise exports of cotton yarn in terms of quantity and value during July, 2016 of the current financial year and corresponding period of last year are given below:-

Rice maintained its first position in its group during July, 2016 as in the previous month. In this month it fetched Rs. 8,795.36 million as against Rs. 15,067.29 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 9,273.62 million in July, 2015 showing a decrease of 41.63% over June, 2016 and by 5.16% over July, 2015.

During July, 2016 its exports amounted to Rs. 8,795.36 million as against the exports of Rs. 9,273.62 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 5.16%. United Arab Emirates was the leading buyer of rice during July, 2016 with its share of 17.99% in the total exports of this item. Other major buyers were Kenya (9.82%), Cyprus (5.45%), United Kingdom (4.15%), Afghanistan (3.91%), Saudi Arabia (3.88%) and Yemen (3.55%). These seven countries accounted for 48.76% of total exports of rice during this period.

Unit price of rice "Other Varieties" decreased to Rs. 43,517.65 per tonne in July, 2016 from Rs. 41,027.20 in July, 2015 showing a rise of 6.07%.

Petroleum Products

Petroleum products came down its seventh position in its group during July, 2016 from sixth iin the previous month. In this month its exports amounted to Rs. 614.55 million as against Rs. 740.45 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 594.19 million in July, 2015 showing a decrease of 17.00% over June, 2016 but increase by 3.43% over July, 2015.

In terms of quantity 14,314 tonnes of petroleum products were exported during July, 2016 of current financial year as against 8,275 tonnes exported during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 72.98%.

The main buyers of petroleum products during July, 2016 were Afghanistan (Rs. 524.26 million), India (Rs. 54.71 million) and United Arab Emirates (Rs. 35.59 million). These three countries accounted for 100.00% share of total exports of petroleum products during July, 2016 as against their combined share of 99.58% during the same period of last year.

Leather

Leather came up to second position in its group during July, 2016 from fifth in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 2,700.20 million as against Rs. 2,980.75 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 3,167.81 million in July, 2015 showing a decrease of 9.41% over June, 2016 and by 14.76% over July, 2015.

In terms of quantity 1,276,506 sq. meter of leather was exported during July, 2016 as against 1,570,857 sq. meters exported during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 18.74%.

The main buyers of leather during July, 2016 were China (Rs. 365.46 million), Hong Kong (Rs. 362.90 million), Bangladesh (Rs. 254.08 million), Italy (Rs. 218.26 million), Viet Nam (Rs. 189.88 million), Korea Rep. of (Rs. 180.66 million), India (Rs. 157.76 million), Spain (Rs. 132.96 million) Germany (Rs. 121.33 million) and United Arab Emirates (Rs. 104.29 million), whose combined share in total exports of leather was 77.31% as against their combined share of 74.35% during the same period of last year.

Carpets, Carpeting, Rugs & Mats

Carpets, carpeting, rugs and mats came up to sixth position in its group during July, 2016 from seventh in the previous month. Its exports in July, 2016 amounted to Rs.725.47 million as against Rs. 687.21 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 827.49 million in July, 2015 showing an increase of 5.57% over June, 2016 but lover by 12.33% over July, 2015.

In terms of quantity 131,917 sq. meters of carpets, carpeting, rugs & mats were exported during July, 2016 of current financial year as against 146,639 sq. meters exported during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 10.04%.

The average unit price of carpets of wool hand knotted was Rs. 5909.17 per sq. meter during July, 2016 as against Rs. 6334.19 per sq. meter in the corresponding period of last year showing a fall of 6.71%. U. S. A. (Rs. 380.23 million), United Kingdom (Rs. 48.39 million), Germany (Rs. 42.27 million), Japan (Rs. 38.00 million), Mexico (28.48 million), Austria (Rs. 22.66 million), South Africa (Rs. 21.006 million), France (Rs. 18.86 million), Australia (Rs. 18.05 million), and Italy (Rs. 15.05 million), were the main buyers of carpets, carpeting, rugs & mats during July, 2016. They together accounted for 87.48% during July, 2016 as compared to their combined share of 75.48% during the same period of last year.

Raw Cotton

Raw Cotton maintained its fourth position in its group during July, 2016 in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 342.94 million as against Rs. 66.40 million in June, 2016 and Rs. 569.92 million in July, 2015 showing an increase of 416.48% over June, 2016 but decreased by 39.83% over July, 2015.

In terms of quantity 1,921 tonnes of raw cotton was exported during July, 2016 as against 3475 tonnes exported during the same period of last year showing a decrease of 44.72%.

The main buyers of raw cotton during July, 2016 were Viet Nam (Rs. 164.92 million), India (Rs. 81.95 million), Thailand (Rs. 31.81 million) and Indonesia (Rs. 12.62 million). They together accounted for 84.94% of total exports of raw cotton during July, 2016 as against their combined share of 93.71% during the corresponding period of last year.

III - Direction of Exports

Exports by Territories/Regions and Major countries during July, 2016 compared to the same month of last year are given in table 2 and 3 respectively.

During the month of July, 2016, (37.49%) of total exports went to European Union as against 31.83% in July, 2015. The share of North America during July, 2016 was 18.70% as against 20.82% in July, 2015. The share of Middle East during July, 2016 was 10.71% as against 11.61% in July, 2015. Country-wise, U.S.A. was at the top of the exports list for July, 2016 followed by United Kingdom, China, Afghanistan, Germany and United Arab Emirates. The share of these six countries in total exports for July, 2016 was 54.82% as against their combined share of 52.42% in July, 2015.

IV - Exports by Economic Categories

Export of primary commodities during the current month decreased to Rs. 16,689.77 million from Rs. 19,864.40 million by 15.98% over the corresponding month of last year. Its share in total export decreased to 10.81% from 12.30% during this period.

During July, 2016 exports of semi-manufactures amounted to Rs. 17,104.54 million as against Rs. 21,302.21 million during July 2015 showing a decrease of 19.71%. The share of Semi-manufactures in total export decreased to 11.07% in this month from 13.19% in the corresponding month of last year.

Export of manufactured goods during July, 2016 increased to Rs. 120,668.64 million from Rs. 120,366.88 million during July, 2015 showing an increase of 0.25%. The share in total export during the month increased to 78.12% from 74.52% during the corresponding month of last year.

I – Imports by Group/Commodities

Imports into Pakistan during July, 2016 amounted to Rs. 370,368.82 million as against the imports of Rs. 464,126.83 million in the previous month and Rs. 340,518.82 million during the corresponding month of last year showing a decrease of 20.20% over previous month but increased by 8.77% over the corresponding month of last year.

Comparative figures of imports by group/commodities during July, 2016, June, 2016 and July, 2015 are given in Table-4.

Food Group

During July, 2016 the 5 selected commodities of Food Group contributed 7.01% of total imports in which the share of palm oil, pulses and tea were 2.96%, 1.74% and 1.19% respectively.

Machinery & Transport Group

During July, 2016 Machinery & Transport Group contributed 26.29% of total imports in which the share of Machinery and Transport equipment were 20.61% and 5.68% respectively.

Petroleum Group

During July, 2016 Petroleum Group contributed 19.40% of total imports in which the share of Petroleum products and Petroleum crude were 13.92% and 5.48% respectively.

Textile Group

During July, 2016 Textile Group contributed 2.66% of total imports in which the share of Synthetic fibre and Synthetic & artificial silk yarn were 1.43% and 1.22% respectively.

Chemical Group

During July, 2016 Chemical Group contributed 16.40% of total imports in which the share of Chemical (excl. fertilizer, medicines & insecticide) were (12.16%), Medicinal products (2.49%), Fertilizer manufactured (1.29%) and Insecticide (0.45%).

Metal Group

During July, 2016 Metal Group contributed 5.60% of total imports in which the share of Iron & steel and Iron & steel scrap were 3.81% and 1.79% respectively.

Miscellaneous Group



Transport Equipment

III - Direction of Imports

Imports by Territories/Regions and major countries during July, 2016 compared with July, 2015 are given in table 5 and 6 respectively.

During July, 2016 (11.29%) of total imports were from European Union. The share of imports of Middle East was 27.30% and North America 4.77%. Country-wise, China was at the top of imports list during July, 2016 followed by United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, U. S. A. and Japan. The combined share of these six countries during July, 2016 was 54.28% as against their combined share of 59.04% during July, 2015.
