

**Revised Quantum Index Numbers of Large Scale Manufacturing Industries (QIM) for:**

- **September, 2015 and September, 2014.**
- **July-September 2015-16 and July-September 2014-15**
- **Sector wise growth for September, 2015 and Jul-Sep 2015-16**
- **Graphical representation of Monthly Quantum Index**
- **Production of Selected Items of Large Scale Manufacturing Industries**

The revised quantum indices of **Large Scale Manufacturing Industries (LSMI)** for September, 2015 with base year 2005-06, have been developed on the basis of latest data supplied by the source agencies. The indices for July-September, 2015-16 along with percentage changes and growth impact by source are as follows:

2. The over-all output of LSMI increased by **3.89%** for July-September, 2015-16 compared to July-September, 2014-15.

4. The LSMI output increased by **2.10%** for September, 2015 compared to September, 2014 and decreased by **1.24%** if compared to August 2015. Month-wise trend of QIM from September, 2013 to September, 2015 is given in the following graph:-
