# 2. Detail Description:

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics collects the retail and the wholesale prices and computes the Consumer Price Index (CPI), Wholesale Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis and Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis. In June, 2013 the CPI, SPI and WPI increased by 0.72%, 2.45% and 1.00% over May, 2013 respectively.

Main contributors to month-on-month and year-on-year are given below:

- i) <u>Month-on-month</u> Top few commodities which varied from previous month i.e. June, 2013 over May, 2013 are given below:
  - a. <u>Food Items</u> Increased: Tomatoes (23.19%), Chicken (23.16%), Potatoes (19.16%), Gur (8.42%), Beverages (3.58%), Wheat (2.63%), Wheat Flour (2.59%), Wheat Product (2.30%), Pulse Moong (2.27%), Beans (2.02%), Cigarettes (1.82%), Pulse Masoor (1.69%), Sugar (1.56%), Milk Fresh (1.54%) and Betel Leaves & Nuts (1.52%).

**Decreased:** Onions (14.18%), Fresh Fruits (10.10%), Fresh Vegetables (4.21%), Eggs (2.62%), Besan (1.99%), Pulse Gram (1.27%), Spices (0.30%) and Gram Whole (0.02%).

**Non-food Items Increased:** Cosmetics (6.96%), Footwear (6.16%), Motor Fuel (2.16%), Sewing Needle & Dry Cell (1.76%), Construction Wage Rates (1.30%), Text Books (1.23%), Washing Soap (1.20%), Marriage Hall charges and Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (1.12% each), Blades (0.91%) and Cotton Cloth (0.87%).
 **Decreased:** Personal Equipments (2.28%).

- ii) <u>Year-on-year</u> Top few commodities which varied from corresponding month of previous year i.e. June, 2013 over June, 2012 are given below:-
  - a. <u>Food Items</u> Increased: Tomatoes (125.1%), Onions (87.82%), Fresh Vegetables (29.28%), Wheat Flour (19.99%), Wheat (18.58%), Tea (16.92%), Wheat Products (16.17%), Chicken (15.59%), Gur (14.07%), Rice (12.21%), Cereals (11.88%), Honey (10.45%), Beans (9.69%), Beverages (9.22%), Dry Fruits (9.18%) and Milk Powder (8.43%).
    Decreased: Pulse Gram (21.40%), Spices (18.28%), Gram Whole (15.61%), Besan (13.93%), Fresh Fruits (11.26%), Vegetable Ghee (5.47%), Pulse Mash (4.86%), Pulse Moong (3.41%), Sugar (2.08%) and Potatoes (0.16%).
  - **Non-food Items** Increased: Woolen Readymade Garments (18.47%), Dopatta (16.60%), Cotton Cloth (14.91%), Cleaning & Laundary (14.55%), Newspaper (13.68%), Woolen Cloth (13.41%), Tailoring (13.06%) and Text Books (12.95%).
    **Decreased:** Gas (45.61%) and Motor Fuel (0.61%).

#### iii) Average Inflation Rate

The Consumer Price Index of July- June, 2012-13 has increased by 7.36% over July-June, 2011-12 as per details given below:-

The items that witnessed significant rise in their prices include Text Books (35.24%), Besan (23.84%), Pulse Gram (21.66%), Woolen Readymade Garments (20.16%), Honey (18.98%), Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (18.95%), Dopatta (18.78%), Cleaning & Laundry (17.55%), Household Servant (17.12%), Beans (16.87%), Utensils (16.65%), Motor Vehicles Tax (16.55%), Cigarettes (15.92%), Firewood Whole (15.62%), Tailoring and Readymade Garments (15.58% each).

#### 3. Core inflation of CPI

#### i. Trimmed Core Inflation

During the month of June, 2013 over June, 2012, the trimmed core inflation has been observed as 6.8%, while it was 11.1% during June, 2012 over June, 2011.

#### ii. Non-Food & Non-Energy Core Inflation

During the month of June, 2013 over June, 2012, the Non-food & Non-energy core inflation has been observed as 7.8%, while it was 11.4% during June, 2012 over June, 2011.
