2. Detail Description:

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics collects the retail and the wholesale prices and computes the Consumer Price Index (CPI), Wholesale Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis and Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis. In March, 2014 the CPI, SPI and WPI increased by 0.96%, 2.15% and 0.34% respectively.

Main contributors to month-on-month and year-on-year are given below:

- i) Month-on-month Top few commodities which varied from previous month i.e. Mar, 2014 over Feb, 2014 are given below:
 - a. <u>Food Items</u> Increased: Tomatoes (53.32%), Potatoes (39.17%), Eggs (15.29%), Fresh Fruits (9.28%), Pulse Moong (6.31%), Chicken (6.11%), Sugar (4.21%), Fish (2.79%), Pulse Masoor (2.44%), Betel Leaves & Nuts (1.53%), Pulse Mash (1.29%), Vegetable Ghee (1.22%), Wheat (1.16%), Condiments (1.06%), and Wheat Flour (1.03%).

Decreased: Tea (3.49%), Besan (1.12%), Mustard Oil (0.09%), and Gram Whole (0.08%).

b. Non-food Items Increased: Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (2.16%), Personal Equipments (1.51%), Newspapers (1.43%), Drugs & Medicines (1.30%), Cosmetics (1.25%), Cotton Cloth (1.22%), and Dopatta (0.97%).

Decreased: Motor Fuel (1.48%), Firewood Whole (0.16%), and Woolen Readymade Garments (0.09%).

- **Year-on-year** Top few commodities which varied from corresponding month of previous year i.e. Mar, 2014 over Mar, 2013 are given below:
 - a. <u>Food Items</u> Increased: Potatoes (93.20%), Chicken (27.25%), Eggs (26.14%), Pulse Moong (25.78%), Pulse Masoor (22.73%), Fresh Vegetables (21.85%), Wheat (19.20%), Wheat Products (18.35%), Wheat Flour (17.99%), Cigarettes (16.20%), Beans (13.71%), and Readymade Food (13.20%).

Decreased: Besan (23.34%), Tomatoes (21.56%), Pulse Gram (20.95%), Gram Whole (15.73%), Onions (10.29%), Tea (3.51%), Spices (3.16%) and Mustard Oil (1.99%).

b. Non-food Items Increased: Postal Service (23.66%), Cosmetics (19.83%), Electricity (15.82%), Sewing Needle & Dry Cell (15.80%), Doctor (MBBS) Clinic Fee (14.79%), Cotton Cloth (13.40%), Woolen Readymade Garments (13.38%), Tailoring (12.95%), Text Books (12.04%) and Utensils (11.53%).

The Consumer Price Index of July- Mar, 2013-14 has increased by 8.64% over July-Mar, 2012-13 as per details given below:-

Top few commodities which varied from previous year average i.e. July-Mar, 2012-13 are given below:-

Increased: Potatoes (43.98%), Tomatoes (42.68%), Onions (41.49%), Postal Services (24.75%), Wheat (23.33%), Wheat Flour (22.18%), Wheat Products (19.61%), Fresh Vegetables (17.33%), Gur (16.73%), Cosmetics (16.49%), Cigarettes (15.33%), tea (15.21%), woolen readymade garments (15.12%), and Text Books (15.05%).

Decreased: Pulse Gram (28.22%), Besan (26.10%), Gram Whole (20.82%), Spices (15.14%), Vegetable Ghee (2.36%), Pulse Mash (1.52%), Mustard Oil (1.42%), Fresh Fruits (1.30%), Cooking Oil (1.06%), and Personal Equipments (0.11%).

3. Core inflation of CPI

i. Trimmed Core Inflation

During the month of Mar, 2014 over Mar, 2013, the trimmed core inflation has been observed as 8.1%, while it was 8.4% during Mar, 2013 over Mar, 2012.

ii. Non-Food & Non-Energy Core Inflation

During the month of Mar, 2014 over Mar, 2013, the Non-food & Non-energy core inflation has been observed as 7.6%, while it was 9.0% during Mar, 2013 over Mar, 2012.
