Review of Foreign Trade February, 2011

EXPORTS

The total Exports of Pakistan during February, 2011 amounted to Rs 182,692.79 million as against Rs. 197,668.88 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 128,924.95 million during February, 2010 showing a decrease of 7.58% over January, 2011 while an increase by 41.70% February, 2010.

Exports during July – February, 2011 totalled Rs. 1,307,007.91million as against Rs. 1,027,153.26 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 27.25 percent.

In terms of U.S dollars, the exports during February, 2011 amounted to \$ 2,141.41 million as against \$2,307.12 million in January, 2011 and \$1,518.57 million during February, 2010 showing a decrease of 7.18% over January, 2011 while higher by 41.01% over February, 2010.

In terms of U.S. dollars, the exports during Exports during July-February, 2011 totalled \$15,263.41 million as against \$12,302.82 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 24.06 percent.

IMPORTS

The total Imports of Pakistan during February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 260,500.11million as against Rs. 295,103.13 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 212,637.34 million during February, 2010 showing a decrease of 11.73% over January, 2011 while higher by 22.51% over February, 2010.

Imports during July – February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 2,192,188.67million as against Rs. 1,821,974.23 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 20.32 percent.

In terms of US dollars, the imports during February, 2011 amounted to \$3,053.42 million as against \$3,444.34 million in January, 2011 and \$2,504.59 million during showing a decrease of 11.35% over January, 2011 while an increase by 12.91% over February, 2011.

In term of U.S. dollars, the imports during July – February, 2011 amounted \$25,599.50 million as against \$21,819.75 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 17.32 percent.

Based on the above figures of exports & imports the balance of trade in February, 2011 was unfavourable for Pakistan to the tune of 77,807.32 million rupees equal to US \$ 912.01 million, and the balance of trade during July – February, 2011 was also unfavourable to the tune of 885,180.76 million rupees equal to U.S. \$ 10,336.09 million.

I - Exports by Group/Commodities

The total Exports of Pakistan during February, 2011 amounted to Rs 182,692.79 million as against Rs. 197,688.88 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 128,924.95 million during February, 2010 showing a decrease of 7.58% over January, 2011 while higher by 41.70% February, 2010.

Exports during July – February, 2011 totalled Rs. 1,307,007.91million as against Rs. 1,027,153.26 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 27.25percent.

Comparative figure of exports by group/commodities during February, 2011 compared to January, 2011 and February, 2010 are given in table-1 and cumulative exports for the period July – February, 2011 of current financial year compared to the corresponding period of last year are given in table-2.

Primary Commodities

During February, 2011 the 6 selected commodities of Primary Commodities contributed 14.63% of total exports in which the share of Rice was (8.63%), Fruit, vegetables & preparation thereof (2.78%) and Raw cotton (excl. linters) (2.18%).

During July – February, 2011 these 6 commodities contributed 14.06% of total exports showing a decrease of 11.18% as against their combined share of 15.83% during the corresponding period of last year.

Textile Manufactures

During February, 2011 the 9 selected commodities of Textile Manufactures contributed 51.95% of total exports in which the share of Cotton yarn was (11.84%), Cotton fabrics (10.35%), Knitwear (8.75%), Bed-wear (7.26%) and Articles of apparel & clothing accessories (excl. knitwear) (5.88%).

During July – February, 2011 these 9 commodities contributed 53.46% of total exports showing an increase of 4.09% as against their combined share of 51.36% during the corresponding period of last year.

Other Manufactures

During February, 2011 the 7 selected commodities of Other Manufactures contributed 10.69% of total exports in which the share of Petroleum products was (4.14%), Leather clothes & accessories (1.83%), Leather (1.56%), Sports goods (excl. toys) (1.32%) and Surgical instruments (0.90%).

During July – February, 2011 these 7 commodities contributed 13.35% of total exports showing an increase of 2.22% as against their combined share of 13.06% during the corresponding period of last year.

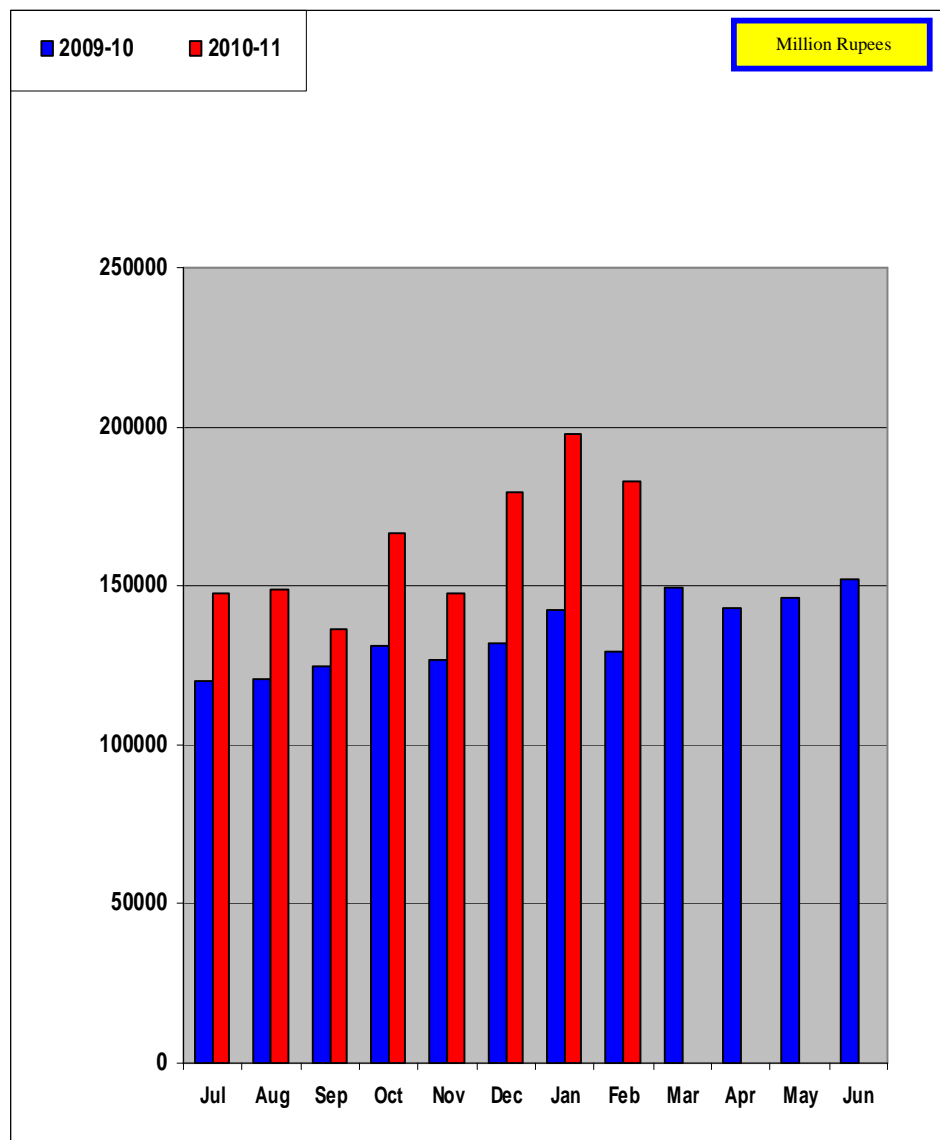

II – Analysis of Selected Commodities of Exports

Cotton Fabrics

Cotton fabrics maintained its second position in its group during February 2011 as the same position in the previous month. During this month its exports amounted to Rs. 18,914.52million as against Rs. 17,692.59 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 13,461.72 million during February, 2010 showing an increase of 6.91% over January, 2011 and by 40.51% over February, 2010.

During July – February, 2011 of current financial year 1,401,374 thousand sq. meters of cotton fabrics valued at Rs. 132,997.47million were exported as against 1,179,809 thousand sq. meters valued at Rs. 97,477.79 million during the same period of last year showing an increase of 18.78% in terms of quantity and by 36.44% in terms of value. During July – February, 2011 the average unit price of cotton fabrics increased to Rs.94.91 per sq. meter from Rs. 82.62 per sq. meter during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 14.88 percent. Main buyers of cotton fabrics during July – February, 2011 of current financial year were Turkey (Rs. 19,617.52million), Bangladesh (Rs. 14,599.57 million), Italy (Rs. 10,084.71million), Cambodia (Rs. 8,572.46million), Germany (Rs. 6,267.83million), Sri Lanka (Rs. 6,022.88 million), U.S.A. (Rs. 5,521.38million), Spain (Rs. 4,830.89million), Belgium (Rs. 3,986.78million), and South Africa (Rs. 3,311.82million). Their total take-off accounted for 62.27% of total exports of cotton cloth as compared to their combined share of 58.95% during the same period of last year.

Variety-wise exports of cotton fabrics during July – February, 2011 of current financial year and the corresponding period of last year are given below.

Cotton Yarn

Cotton yarn maintained its first position in its group during February, 2011 as the same position in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 21,626.16 million as against Rs. 18,913.77 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 7,819.19 million in February, 2010 showing an increase of 14.34% over January, 2011 and by 176.58% over February, 2010.

During July – February, 2011 exports of cotton yarn amounted to Rs. 124,287.66million as against Rs. 82,280.11 million in the corresponding period of last year showing a rise of 51.05percent. In terms of quantity 379,050 thousand Kg. of cotton yarn was exported during July – February, 2011 of current financial year as against 470,940 thousand Kg. during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 19.51 percent. The average unit price of cotton yarn for the period July – February, 2011 of current financial year was Rs. 327.89per Kg. as against Rs. 174.72 per Kg. in the same period of last year showing an increase of 87.68 percent.

China (Rs. 58,133.01million), Hong Kong (Rs. 17,531.50million), Bangladesh (Rs. 10,477.76million), Korea Rep. of (Rs. 6,563.23million), Portugal (Rs. 3,848.04million), Turkey (Rs. 3,218.71million) and Japan (Rs. 2,913.66million) were major buyers of cotton yarn during this period. Their combined share accounted for 82.62%of total exports of cotton yarn as compared to their combined share of 82.77%during the same period of last year.

Rice

Rice maintained its first position in its group during February, 2011 as in the previous month. In this month it fetched Rs. 15,760.84million as against Rs. 15,932.50 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 17,509.02million in February, 2010 showing a decrease of 1.08% over January, 2011 and by 9.98% over February, 2010.

During July – February, 2011 its exports amounted to Rs. 119,036.89million as against the exports of Rs. 114,339.68 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 4.11percent. U.A.E. was the leading buyer of rice during July – February, 2011 with its share of 14.90% in the total exports of this item. Other major buyers were Saudi Arabia (5.58%), Oman (5.06%), Iran (Islamic Rep.) (4.91%), Bangladesh (4.58%), Afghanistan (4.43%) and Mozambique (4.29%). These seven countries accounted for 43.77% of total exports of rice during this period.

Unit price of rice basmati for February, 2011 was Rs. 72,350.22 per tonne as against Rs. 71,792.98 in February, 2010 showing a rise of 0.78 percent. Average unit price of this variety for July – February, 2011 of current financial year was Rs. 69,080.43 per tonne as against Rs. 68,851.04 for the same period of last year showing a rise of 0.33 percent.

Unit price of rice "Other Varieties" increased to Rs. 40,982.82 per tonne in February, 2011 from Rs. 36,626.04 in February, 2010 showing a rise of 11.90 percent. The average unit price of rice "Other Varieties" for July – February, 2011 at Rs. 39,776.71 per tonne was also higher by 12.89% compared to average unit price of Rs. 35,236.28 per tonne for the same period of last year.

Petroleum Products

Petroleum products maintained its first position in its group during February, 2011 as the same position in the previous month. In this month its exports amounted to Rs. 7,563.27million as against Rs. 15,568.44 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 7,722.76 million in February, 2010 showing a decrease of 51.42% over January, 2011 and by 2.07% over February, 2010.

Exports of this item during July – February, 2011 of current financial year stood at Rs. 74,882.45 million as against exports of Rs. 50,973.53 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 46.90 percent.

In terms of quantity 1,132,984 tonnes of petroleum products were exported during July – February, 2011 of current financial year as against 917,581tonnes exported during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 23.48 percent.

The main buyers of petroleum products during July – February, 2011 were Afghanistan (Rs. 43,972.50 million), U.A.E. (Rs. 19,733.38 million) and Korea Rep. of (Rs. 1,969.67million). These three countries accounted for 87.70% of total exports of petroleum products during July – February, 2011 as against their combined share of 88.71% during the same period of last year.

Leather

Leather maintained its third position in its group during February, 2011 as the same position in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 2,849.21million as against Rs. 2,988.83million in January, 2011 and Rs. 2,068.13 million in February, 2010 showing a decrease of 4.67% over January, 2011 while higher by 37.77% over February, 2010.

Exports of this item during July – February, 2011 totaled Rs. 23,684.17million as against Rs. 15,804.77 million during the corresponding period of last year showing a rise of 49.85 percent. In terms of quantity 17,356,421 sq. meter of leather was exported during July – February, 2011 as against 13,570,674 sq. meters exported during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 27.90 percent.

The main buyers of leather during July – February, 2011 were Hong Kong (Rs. 6,807.71million), Italy (Rs. 2,799.99million), China (Rs. 2,673.24million), Korea Rep. of (Rs. 2,396.74million), Turkey (Rs. 1,197.20million), Viet Nam (Rs. 725.51million) and Germany (Rs. 706.21million), whose combined share in total exports of leather was 73.07% as against their combined share of 73.16% during the same period of last year.

Carpets, Carpeting, Rugs & Mats

Carpets, carpeting, rugs and mats came down to seventh position in its group during February, 2011 from its sixth position in the previous month. Its exports in February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 740.43million as against Rs. 982.15 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 796.37 million in February, 2010 showing a decrease of 24.61% over January, 2011 and by 7.02% over February, 2010.

Exports of this item for July – February, 2011 of current financial year amounted to Rs. 7,289.20million as against Rs. 7,568.70million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 3.69 percent.

In terms of quantity 1,545,615 sq. meters of carpets, carpeting, rugs & mats were exported during July – February, 2011 of current financial year as against 1,660,318 sq. meters exported during the corresponding period of last year showing a decrease of 6.91 percent.

The average unit price of carpets of wool hand knotted was Rs. 5,337.58per sq. meter during July– February, 2011 as against Rs. 4,997.47 per sq. meter in the corresponding period of last year showing a rise of 6.81 percent. U.S.A. (Rs. 2,334.66 million), Germany (Rs. 850.51 million), Italy (Rs. 728.21 million), Turkey (Rs. 514.27million), France (Rs. 338.98million), South Africa (Rs. 287.84million) and U.K. (Rs. 280.61million) were the main buyers of carpets, carpeting, rugs & mats during July – February, 2011. They together accounted for 73.19% during July – February, 2011 as compared to their combined share of 72.32% during the same period of last year.

Raw Cotton

Raw Cotton came up to third position in its group during February, 2011 from its fourth position in the previous month. Its exports in this month amounted to Rs. 3,978.77million as against Rs. 1,461.66 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 1,328.82 million in February, 2010 showing an increase of 172.21% over January, 2011 and by 199.42% over February, 2010.

Exports of this item during July – February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 19,697.02 million as against Rs. 15,885.38 million showing an increase of 23.99% compared to the same period of last year. In terms of quantity 102,713 tonnes of raw cotton was exported during July – February, 2011 as against 156,201tonnes exported during the same period of last year showing a decrease of 34.24 percent. The average unit price of cotton American was Rs. 158,141.03per tonne during July – February, 2011 as against 112,951.07 per tonne showing an increase of 40.01percent.

The main buyers of raw cotton during July – February, 2011 were Bangladesh (Rs. 7,432.95 million), China (Rs. 5,501.28 million) and Indonesia (Rs. 1,832.83million). They together accounted for 74.97% of total exports of raw cotton during July – February, 2011 as against their combined share of 51.58% during the corresponding period of last year.

Quantity and value data of exports of raw cotton during July – February, 2011 and the corresponding period of last year are given below:-

III - Direction of Exports

Exports by Territories/Regions and Major countries during February, 2011 compared with February, 2010 are given in table 3 & 4 and cumulative Exports by Territories/Regions and Major countries for the period July – February, 2011 of the current financial year compared with the same period of last year are given in table 5 & 6 respectively.

During the month of February, 2011, (24.91%) of total exports went to European Union as against 24.42% in February, 2010. The share of North America during February, 2011 was 13.44% as against 17.47% in February, 2010. The share of Middle East during February, 2011 was 13.60% as against 16.84% in February, 2010. Country-wise, U.S.A. was at the top of the exports list for February, 2011 followed by Bangladesh, Afghanistan, China, Germany and United Kingdom. The share of these six countries in total exports for February, 2011 was 48.66% as against their combined share of 41.67% in February, 2010.

During July – February, 2011 the share of European Union in total Exports was 24.53% as against 24.22% in February, 2010. The share of North America decreased to 17.33% from 18.44% during the same period of last year. The share of Middle East decreased to 17.74% from 19.13% during the same period of last year.

Country-wise, U.S.A. was at the top of the exports list for July – February, 2011 followed by Afghanistan, U.A.E., China, United Kingdom and Germany. The share of these six countries in total exports for July –February, 2011 of the current financial year was 49.76% as against their combined share of 49.71% in the same period of last year.

IV - Exports by Economic Categories

Performance of exports by economic categories during February, 2011 and July – February, 2011 of the current financial year compared to the same period of last year are shown in table-7.

During February, 2011 exports of primary commodities increased by 61.86%, semi-manufactures by 143.36% and of manufactured goods by 23.68% during the current month as compared to the same month of last year.

During July – February, 2011 exports of primary commodities were higher by 18.65%, semi-manufactures by 59.79% and manufactured goods by 24.51% as compared to the same period of last year.

I – Imports by Group/Commodities

Imports into Pakistan during February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 260,500.11million as against the imports of Rs. 295,103.13 million in the previous month and Rs. 212,637.33 million during the corresponding month of last year showing a decrease of 11.73% over previous month while higher by 22.51% over the corresponding month of last year.

Imports during July – February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 2,192,188.67million as against Rs. 1,821,974.23 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 20.32 percent.

Comparative figures of imports by group/commodities during February, 2011, January, 2011 and February, 2010 are given in Table-8 and cumulative imports for July – February, 2011 of current financial year and the previous year are given in Table-9.

Food Group

During February, 2011 the 5 selected commodities of Food group contributed 7.72% of total imports in which the share of Palm oil and Tea were 5.35% and 1.00% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this group contributed 7.34% of total imports showing an increase of 38.23% as against their combined share of 5.31% during the corresponding period of last year.

Machinery & Transport Group

During February, 2011 Machinery & Transport group contributed 17.36% of total imports in which the share of Machinery and Transport equipment were 12.51% and 4.85% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this Group contributed 19.08% of the total imports showing a decrease of 12.96% as against their combined share of 21.92% during the corresponding period of last year.

Petroleum Group

During February, 2011 Petroleum group contributed 24.75% of total imports in which the share of Petroleum crude and Petroleum products were 12.90% and 11.84% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this group contributed 28.07% of total imports showing a decrease of 2.80% as against their combined share of 28.88% during the corresponding period of last year.

Textile Group

During February, 2011 Textile group contributed 2.88% of total imports in which the share of Synthetic & artificial silk yarn and Synthetic fibre were 1.47% and 1.40% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this group contributed 2.66% of total import showing an increase of 31.68% as against their combined share of 2.02% during the corresponding period of last year.

Chemical Group

During February, 2011 Chemical group contributed 16.51% of total imports in which the share of Chemical (excl. fertilizer, medicines & insecticide) were (13.55%), Medical products (1.50%), Fertilizer manufactured (1.10%) and Insecticide (0.37%).

During July – February, 2011 chemical group contributed 15.06% of the total imports showing a decrease of 13.00% as against their combined share of 17.31% during the corresponding period of last year.

Metal Group

During February, 2011 Metal group contributed 4.23% of total imports in which the share of Iron & steel and Iron & steel scrap were 3.39% and 0.84% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this group contributed 4.35% of total imports showing a decrease of 12.12% as against their combined share of 4.95% during the corresponding period of last year.

Miscellaneous Group

During February, 2011 miscellaneous group contributed 1.78% of total imports in which the share of Paper & paper products and Tyres & tubes were 1.06% and 0.72% respectively.

During July – February, 2011 this group contributed 1.51% of total imports showing an increase of 30.17% as against their combined share of 1.16% during the corresponding period of last year.

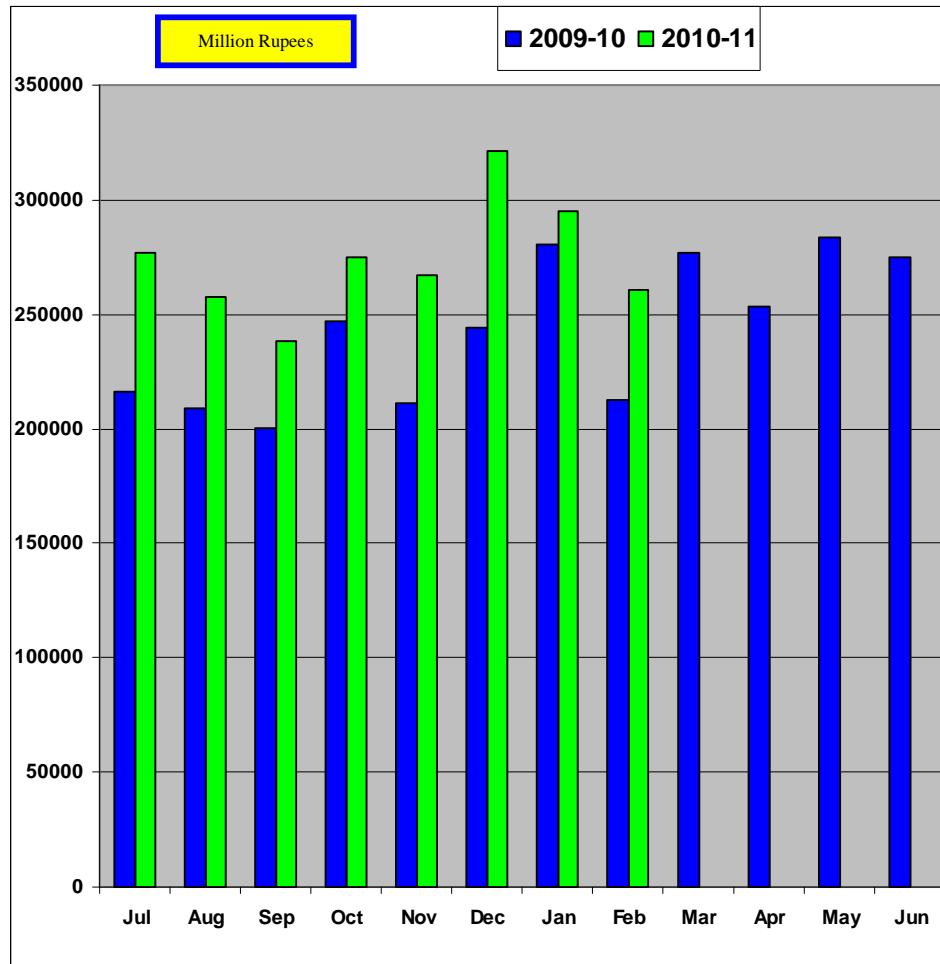

II – Analysis of Selected Commodities of Imports

POL

Imports of POL during February, 2011 valued at Rs. 64,461.15million was lower by 23.84% compared to January, 2011 Rs. 84,637.34 million while higher by 13.92% compared to February, 2010 Rs. 56,586.95 million. Cumulative imports of POL during the period July – February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 615,243.72million as against Rs. 526,199.14 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 16.92 percent.

The share of POL in total imports in February, 2011 was 24.75% as against 28.68% in January, 2010 and by 26.61% in February, 2010. During July – February, 2011 its share was 28.07% as against 28.88% in the corresponding period of last year.

Chemicals (Excluding fertilizer, insecticide & medicines)

Imports of chemicals (Excluding fertilizer, insecticide & medicines) during February, 2011 valued at Rs. 35,289.27million was higher by 5.39% compared to January, 2011 Rs. 33,483.42 million and by 37.71% compared to February, 2010 Rs. 25,625.59 million. During July – February, 2011 its imports amounted to Rs. 255,336.61million which was higher by 21.42% compared to imports of Rs. 210,293.78 million during the corresponding period of last year.

The share of chemicals (Excluding fertilizer, insecticide & medicines) in total imports in February, 2011 were 13.55% as against 11.35% in January, 2011 and 12.05% in February, 2010. During July – February, 2011 its share was 11.65% as against 11.54% in the corresponding period of last year.

Machinery

Imports of machinery during February, 2011 valued at Rs. 32,581.07million was lower by 19.40% compared to January, 2011 Rs. 40,421.43 million and by 12.82% compared to February, 2010 Rs. 37,372.94 million. Cumulative imports of machinery during the period July – February, 2011 amounted to Rs. 303,872.47million as against Rs. 294,651.65 million during the corresponding period of last year showing an increase of 3.13 percent.

The share of machinery in total imports in February, 2011 was 12.51% as against 13.70% in January, 2011 and by 17.58% in February, 2010. During July – February, 2011 its share was 13.86% as against 16.17% in the corresponding period of last year.

Transport Equipment

Transport equipment were Rs. 12,644.55million was imported during February, 2011 as against its imports of Rs. 16,743.66 million in January, 2011 and Rs. 11,666.02 million in February, 2010 showing a decrease of 24.48% over January, 2011 while higher by 8.39% over February, 2010. The imports of this item during July – February, 2011 totaled Rs. 114,441.47million which was higher by 9.30% as compared to its imports of Rs. 104,699.35 million during the corresponding period of last year.

The share of transport equipment in total imports in February, 2011 was 4.85% as against 5.67% in January, 2011 and by 5.49% in February, 2010. During July – February, 2011 its share was 5.22% as against the share of 5.75% in the corresponding period of last year.

III - Direction of Imports

Imports by Territories/Regions and major countries during February, 2011 and July – February, 2011 of current financial year compared with the corresponding month and corresponding period of last year are given in table 10, 11, 12 and 13 respectively.

During February, 2011, (8.66%) of total imports were from European Union. The share of imports of Middle East was 32.62% and North America 6.91 percent. Country-wise, China was at the top of imports list during February, 2011 followed by Saudi Arabia, U.A.E, Kuwait, India and Malaysia. The combined share of these six countries during February, 2011 was 59.33% as against their combined share of 55.44% during February, 2010.

During July – February, 2011, the share of imports of European Union was 10.32 percent. The share of imports of Middle East was 36.14% and from North America 5.72% of total imports during this period. Country-wise, China was at the top of the imports list followed by U.A.E, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Malaysia and India during July – February, 2011. Combined share of these six countries in total imports during this period was 57.05% as against their combined share of 51.21% during the corresponding period of last year.

IV - Imports by Economic Categories

During February, 2011 imports of consumer goods increased by 55.87 and of raw materials for consumer goods by 35.10% compared to February, 2010. Imports of capital goods during February, 2011 decreased by 6.89% while of raw material for capital goods increase by 8.48% compared to the same month of last year.

During July – February, 2011 imports of consumer goods were higher by 60.65% and of raw material for consumer goods by 19.87% compared to July – February, 2010. Imports of capital goods during July – February, 2011 increased by 4.11% and of raw material for capital goods by 17.57% compared to the corresponding period of last year.
