TRADE SUMMARY

JUNE, 2018

EXPORTS

The total exports of Pakistan during June, 2018 amounted to Rs. 223,785.78 million showing a decrease of 9.36% over May, 2018 but increased by 12.04% over June, 2017.

In terms of US dollar the export during June, 2018 amounted to \$1,882.05 million showing a decrease of 12.00% over May, 2018 and by 1.28% over June, 2017.

Export during July-June, 2017-18 totaled Rs. 2,555,043.29 million showing an increase of 19.50% over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, exports during July-June, 2017-18 amounted to \$23,212.01 million showing an increase of 13.66%.

IMPORTS

The total imports of Pakistan during June, 2018 amounted to Rs. 672,111.94 million showing an increase of 0.68% over May, 2018 and by 42.18% over June, 2017.

In terms of US dollar the import during June, 2018 amounted to \$5,652.49 million showing a decrease of 2.25% over May, 2018 but increased by 25.28% over June, 2017.

Import during July-June, 2017-18 totaled Rs. 6,039,364.41 million showing an increase of 19.40% over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, imports during July-June, 2017-18 amounted to \$60,794.73 million showing an increase of 14.90%.

TOTAL TRADE

The total trade of Pakistan during June, 2018 amounted to Rs. 895,897.72 million showing a decrease of 2.03% over May, 2018 but increased by 33.23% over June, 2017.

In terms of US dollar the total trade during June, 2018 amounted to \$7,534.54 million showing a decrease of 4.88% over May, 2018 but increased by 17.39% over June, 2017.

Total trade during July-June, 2017-18 totaled Rs. 9,249,939.96 million showing an increase of 20.47% over the corresponding period of last year. In terms of US dollars, total trade during July-June, 2017-18 amounted to \$84,006.74 million showing an increase of 14.56%.

BALANCE OF TRADE

Balance of trade in June, 2018 was unfavorable to Pakistan to the tune of 448,326.16 million in rupees equal to US \$3,770.44 million, whereas during the period of July-June, 2018 it was unfavorable to the tune of 4,139,853.39 million rupees equal to US \$37,582.72 million.

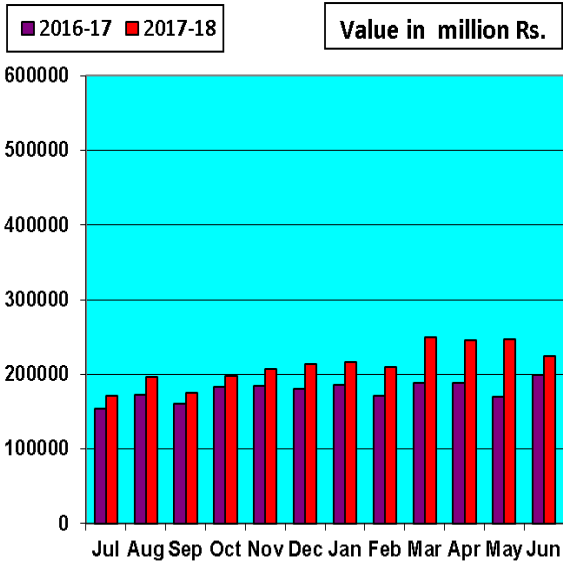

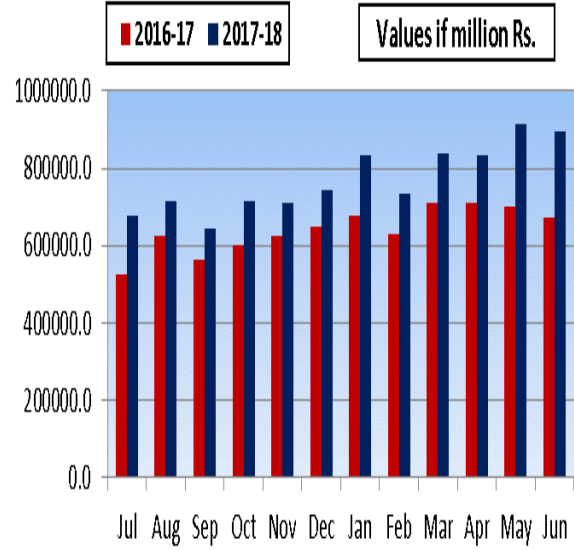

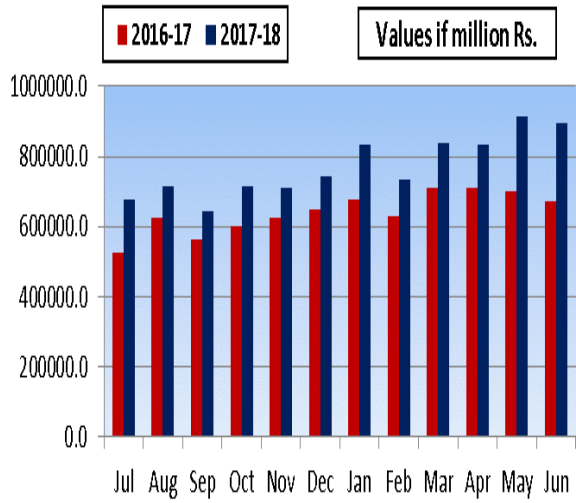
MONTHLY EXPORTS FROM PAKISTAN



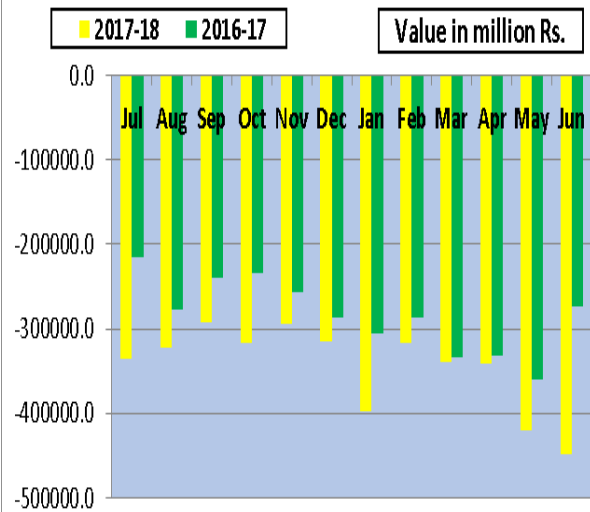
TOTAL TRADE OF PAKISTAN

I – EXPORTS BY GROUP/COMMODITIES

Food Group

During June, 2018 export of goods belonging to Food Group decreased by 30.83% over May, 2018 but increased by 13.63% over June, 2017. Food Group contributed 11.09% of total exports in July, 2018.

The export of food group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 28.45% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 13.71% of total export during July-June, 2017-18.

Textile Group

During June, 2018 export of Textile goods increased by 2.81% over May, 2018 and by 13.06% over June, 2017. Textile Group contributed 61.54% of total exports in June, 2018.

The export of textile group increased by 31.21% for the period of July-June, 2017-18 compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 64.54% of total export during July-June, 2017-18.

Manufactures Group

During June, 2018 export of manufactured goods decreased by 4.16% over May, 2018 but increased by 6.94% over June, 2017. Other Manufactures Group contributed 8.66% of total exports in June, 2018.

Export for manufacturer group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 16.27% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 8.44% of total export during July-June, 2017-18.

II – DIRECTION OF EXPORTS

During the month of June, 2018 the share of European Union in total exports was 37.26% as against 36.57% in June, 2017. The share of North America during June, 2018 was 18.18% as against 20.04% in June, 2017. The share of Middle East during June, 2018 was 9.14% as against 10.98% in June, 2017. Country-wise U. S. A. was at the top of the export list for June, 2018 followed by China, United Kingdom, Germany, Afghanistan and Netherlands. The share of these six countries in total exports for June, 2018 was 48.37% as against 46.71% in June, 2017.

During July-June, 2017-18 the share of European Union in total export was 33.86%. The share of North America decreased to 16.77% from 18.02% during the same period of last year. The share of Middle East decreased to 10.10% from 10.25% during the same period of last year.

Country-wise, U.S.A. was at the top of the export list for July-June, 2017-18 followed by United Kingdom, China, Afghanistan, Germany and Spain. The share of these six countries in total export for July-June, 2017-18 was 46.55% as against 47.78% in the same period of last year.

III – EXPORT BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Export of Primary Commodities during June, 2018 increased by 17.56%, Semi-Manufactures by 34.25% and Manufactured Goods by 8.22%. Whereas, their share in total export stands at 13.61%, 12.03% and 74.36% respectively.

During July-June, 2017-18 export of Primary Commodities increased by 37.25%, Semi-Manufactures by 24.87% and Manufactured Goods by 14.88% over the corresponding period of last year. Whereas the share of primary commodities in total export for the period of July-June, 2017-18 stood at 17.78, 12.04 for semi-manufacturer and 70.18% for manufactured goods.

I – IMPORTS BY GROUP/COMMODITIES

Food Group

During June, 2018 import of goods belonging to Food Group increased by 5.11% over May, 2018 and by 9.87% over June, 2017. This group contributed 4.66% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of food group during July-June, 2017-18 decreased by 1.49% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 5.74% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Machinery & Transport Group

During June, 2018 import of Machinery & Transport items increased by 8.10% over May, 2018 and by 39.63% over June, 2017. This group contributed 26.46% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of machinery & transport group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 11.02% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 26.07% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Petroleum Group

During June, 2018 import of Petroleum and its products decreased by 0.98% over May, 2018 but increased by 56.91% over June, 2017. This group contributed 20.50% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of petroleum group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 31.20% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 19.26% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Textile Group

During June, 2018 import of textile products increased by 2.82% over May, 2018 and by 28.39% over June, 2017. This group contributed 1.98% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of textile group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 13.32% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 1.98% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Chemical Group

During June, 2018 import of Chemical goods decreased by 12.44% over May, 2018 but increased by 35.17% over June, 2017. This group contributed 13.85% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of chemical group during July-June, 2018 increased by 23.51% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 14.69% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Metal Group

During June, 2018 export of Metal products decreased by 4.39% over May, 2018 but increased by 25.21% over June, 2017. This group contributed 5.61% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of metal group during July-June, 2018 increased by 30.37% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 6.61% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

Miscellaneous Group

During June, 2018 exports of miscellaneous commodities decreased by 5.44% over May, 2018 but increased by 3.82% over June, 2017. This group contributed 1.21% of total imports in June, 2018.

The import of miscellaneous group during July-June, 2017-18 increased by 5.86% compared to the same period of last year. This group contributed 1.46% of total imports during July-June, 2017-18.

II – DIRECTION OF IMPORTS

During the month of June, 2018 the share of European Union in total imports was 9.28% as against 10.04% in June, 2017. The share of North America during June, 2018 was 6.14% as against 5.54% in June, 2017. The share of Middle East during June, 2018 was 30.20% as against 27.16% in June, 2017. Country-wise China was at the top of the import list for June, 2018 followed by United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, U.S. America, Indonesia and Japan. The share of these six countries in total exports for June, 2018 was 59.74% as against 57.98% in June, 2017.

During July-June, 2017-18 the share of European Union in total imports was 10.67%. The share of North America decreased to 5.89% from 6.22% during the same period of last year. The share of Middle East increased to 27.35% from 25.62% during the same period of last year. Country-wise China was top on the import list followed by United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, U.S.A., Indonesia and Japan during July-June, 2017-18. The combined share of these six countries in total imports during this period was 57.41% as against their combined share of 59.80% during the same period of last year.

III – IMPORTS BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Imports of Consumer Goods during June, 2018 increased by 31.58%, Raw Material for Consumer Goods by 61.53%, Capital Goods by 19.18% and Raw Material for Capital Goods by 49.34 % over June, 2017. Their respective share in total imports were 13.53%, 49.12%, 27.34 and 10.01% respectively for June, 2018.

During July-June, 2017-18 Imports of Consumer Goods increased by 9.05%, Raw Material for Consumer Good by 30.90%, Capital Goods by 10.42% and Raw Material Goods by 40.37%. Meanwhile the share of Consumer Goods in total imports for the period July-June, 2017-18 stood at 15.99%, Raw Material for Consumer Good at 43.00%, Capital Goods at 31.14% and Raw Material for Capital Goods at 9.87%.
