Also, employees of government and other social and cultural institutions, hotels, restaurants, transport and communication (b) <u>home based activities</u> in (i) <u>Agriculture:</u> Growing or gathering field crops, fruits and vegetables, producing eggs, milk and food. Hunting animals and birds, catching fish, crabs and shellfish; burning charcoal:(ii) <u>Milling and other food processing:</u> Threshing and milling grain, making butter, ghee and cheese, slaughtering livestock, curing hides and skins, preserving meat and fish.
