Provided further that for Government Servants who have completed at least 2 years continuous Government Service, maximum age limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years, wherever applicable.

QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment under the Federal Government on a regular basis in the same Basic Pay Scale in which the post to be filled exists provided the person concerned possesses the qualifications and experience in the relevant field prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion or/initial appointment, or, transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.
