Two meetings of the Cabinet Committee for finalization of Population and Housing Census 2017 results were held on 09-10-2020 and 21-10-2020 respectively under the chair of Syed Ali Haider Zaidi, Federal Minister for Maritime Affairs. Member parliament Sindh, representative from NADRA and PBS has attended the meeting. PBS briefed the committee regarding the Census results & issues, detailed deliberation were made in meetings. Minister Committee finalized their recommendation & submitted to M/O PD&SI the same recommendations have been forwarded with approval of cabinet to CCI for approval of final Census results 2017.

Mr. Muhammad Jehanzeb Khan Deputy Chairman Planning Commission (DCPC) visited Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), on 22nd October, 2020 and chaired a meeting on the activities and initiatives taken by PBS in the wake of COVID-19 pandemic.

Mr. Sarwar Gondal, Member Support Services & Resource Management PBS informed that PBS has shifted from manual data collection to electronic data collection and has achieved an In House capacity to develop Android Based data collection software, Mobile Apps and Dashboards. Being an NSO, PBS has taken the initiative to provide evidence based information about the impact of COVID-19 on the socio-economic condition on the wellbeing of the people capturing information related to Employment, Income, Remittances, Food insecurity, Health, Coping strategies adopted by the household and assets to compile wealth quintiles. Data will be collected electronically and results will be available by end of November 2020. The Deputy Chairman Planning Commission appreciated the efforts of PBS and inaugurated the Field Operation of Special Survey to

Evaluate Impact of COVID-19 on Wellbeing of people. It was further informed that PBS is developing Decision Support Systems and Data Dissemination Systems which would enable the policy makers to take evidence based decision making. PBS officials briefed the DCPC that PBS is successfully conducted census and survey such as Mouza Census, PSLM/HIES Survey, LFS etc and the data will be disseminated to the policy makers and general public through Dash boards in a user friendly manner.

The DCPC appreciated the efforts of PBS and said that reliable and timely data helps the policy makers to take informed decisions. He said that PBS has vast repository of data and PBS should focus on branding itself as an NSO. It should project itself as an efficient and credible technical organization. PBS should be the nucleus of all statistical activities and should start working with partner organizations, universities and provincial departments. PBS should conduct a detailed need assessment survey to make it a next

generation PBS. DCPC also inaugurated the Online Data Quality Assurance Application developed by the IT experts of PBS for District level LFS. This is first ever District level survey covering module on Disability. It will provide quarterly estimates at Provincial level based on 7200 blocks covering 10800 HHs.

PBS Activities

Special Survey for evaluating the Socioeconomic impact of Pandemic COVID-19

PBS being the National Statistical Organization (NSO), its mandate to conduct Nationwide Census & Surveys, it has devised proposals to collect data for providing evidence for informed decisions to the Government/ Policy makers by studying the variables like Employment, Income, Remittances, Food Insecurity, Water, Sanitation & Hygiene, Assistance obtained from Government / Non-Government organizations/Philanthropy and Coping strategies adopted to tackle the shock. Accordingly survey covering 500 blocks has been conducted all over the country including AJK and GB electronically through

tablets. Android based software for data collection was prepared by support Services wing & Virtual Training was imparted to the field staff in the month of October, 2020. Field enumerators and Supervisors participated in the training. Data collection was held from 20 October, 2020 to 5th November, 2020. After successful data collection, data processing was also completed and results were prepared and finalized within a month. Presentation and Report of the

PSLM District Level Survey, 2019-20

Data Processing of PSLM District Level Survey 2019-20 and tabulation are in progress and report will be available by the end of January, 2021.

Mouza Census 2020 Survey

Field enumeration and Data Processing activities of Ninth Mouza census has been successfully completed in September, 2020. Accordingly, key finding report has been prepared and submitted for approval. The information collected through Mouza census will be used for Sampling Frame of IAC. As it is providing updated list of Mouzas / dehs / villages / killies / basties with total land, cultivated land, crops, livestock with other variables As soon as results will be approved, Key Finding Report (KFR) will be available.

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS) is continuously assisting in the form of maps of Covid affected blocks for implementing of Smart Lockdown to NCOC.

LABOUR FORCE SURVEY 2020-21

Labour Force Survey Section is conducting district level LFS 2020-21 first time. The major aim of the survey is to collect a set of comprehensive statistics on the various dimensions of civilian labour force, employed, unemployed, underemployed, mean hours work, wages/salaries etc. for skill development, planning, employment generation, assessing the role and importance of the informal sector and, sizing up the volume, characteristics and contours of employment.

Labour Force Survey Section is carrying out first ever district level survey. The questionnaire and methodology of the survey have been undergoing pertinent improvements through the forum of "Panel on Labour Statistics" comprising all important stakeholders to keep current with best practices. Up till now 50% enumeration/field work of the survey has been completed. Third quarter is in progress while online editing/coding and super checking is in progress.

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics is planning to conduct Integrated Agriculture Census (IAC) 2020-21 merging by three censuses i.e. Agriculture Census, Livestock census and Agriculture Machinery Census. Previously, three separate censuses on



In this regard, FAO being custodian agency of Agriculture Statistics has hired technical consultant Mr. Cristiano Ferraz upon request of PBS for development of sample design of first ever Integrated Agriculture Census (IAC) Pakistan. Two consultative meetings between PBS team and technical expert have been held till December, 2020 and initial work to develop sample design has been started.

Meeting of Mr. Shaukat Zaman, Director (Trade) with Mr. Azeem Afzal, Team Leader of National Single Window (NSW) System, FBR

A meeting with Mr. Azeem Afzal, Team Leader, National Single Window (NSW), FBR, Karachi was held on 28.10.2020 in the office of Director (Trade), Karachi. Mr. Shaukat Zaman, Director (ET), Mr. Sarwar Solangi, CSA and Mr. Atif Hassan, SO (In-Charge), Trade Section participated the meeting on behalf of PBS. Mr. Azeem Afzal informed that Pakistan is obligated to implement trade related NSW under WTO's agreement on trade facilitation by year 2022. He briefed about working and establishment of Pakistan Single Window Company (PSWC), a subsidiary of FBR just like PRAL established under Act (Section 42 of SECP). He further highlighted the WEBOC system and informed that at present 48% to 50% of custom documents are being cleared within 24 hours. Whereas 90% to 95% are being cleared within 5 days. He stated that currently 45 ministries and 72 departments are using trade data of FBR / PRAL. Mr. Shaukat Zaman, Director (ET), informed about the efforts PBS, relating to rebasing of trade and development of Trade Statistics Management Information System (TSMIS). Problems relating to EPZ import data was also discussed. Finally, Mr. Azeem Afzal requested Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS) to share PCT Codes-2017.

External Trade Statistics

Exports from Pakistan: According to provisional figures compiled by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, exports from Pakistan during December, 2020 amounted to Rs. 377,366 million (provisional) and in November, 2020 is Rs.346,063 million showing an increase of 9.05% over November, 2020 and in December, 2019 is Rs.308,032 million showing of 22.51% increase over one year.

Exports during July-December, 2020 totaled Rs. 1,977,766 million (provisional) as Rs. 1,803,776 million during the correspondence period of last year showing an increase of 9.65%.


Imports into Pakistan: Imports into Pakistan during December, 2020 amounted to Rs. 807,873 million (provisional) as against Rs.686,349 million (provisional) in November 2020 and Rs.622,709 million during December, 2019 showing an increase of 17.71 over November, 2020 and of 29.74% over December, 2019. Imports during July-December, 2020 totaled Rs. 4,008,767 million (provisional) as

against Rs. 3,630,229 million during the correspondence period of last year showing an increase of 10.43%.

Price Inflation Situation (Oct-Dec, 2020)

Pakistan Bureau of Statistics is responsible for collection, compilation and preparation of retail / wholesale prices, as well as, computation of price indices. These indices are National Consumer Price Index (NCPI), Urban Consumer Price Index (CPI), Rural Consumer Price Index (RPI) and Wholesale

Price Index (WPI) on monthly basis along with Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) on weekly basis being prepared and released on regular basis. The inflationary situation in Pakistan during the last quarter i.e., Oct-Dec., 2020 is given in Table-1 and Table-2.



In this regard, following steps have been taken:

- 1. Renewal of agreement with Kinnaird College for Women, Lahore is in progress.

United Nations Regional Workshop on Measuring SDG Indicators through Population and Housing Census and Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Data

The workshop was organized by the Statistics Division of ESCAP and the United Nations Statistics Division from 3-6 November, 2020. Mr. Saeed **PBS** Ahmad. Assistant Census Commissioner, represented Pakistan included participants from Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Georgia, China- Hong Kong, SAR, India, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Maldives, Myanmar, Mongolia, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Timor-Leste, Turkey, Turkmenistan, UNFPA Cambodia, and UNFPA Nepal. It was highlighted that Pakistan is collecting SDGs indicator through survey and are mostly covered in Population and Housing Census. First time in census 2017, Pakistan has collected transgender data. Pakistan has suggested some recommendation be included in international census i.e. Transgender must be added to the column of gender. Disability must be included 100 percent in the Census questionnaire. Enumeration area should be linked using GIS. Overall the workshop enhanced capacity

Webinar on Small Area Estimation under UNFPA Work Plan


