
RANKING REPORT FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON (08-JUL-2021)

(Based On Decision Support System On Inflation)

Decision Support System for Inflation (DSSI) developed by Pakistan Bureau of Statistics under the Prime Minister's Digital Pakistan Vision provides timely information on essential commodity prices to the National Price Monitoring Committee, Federal Ministries, Provincial Governments and District Administrations. DSSI provides a Ranking Mechanism of Districts through which the management at Provincial and Federal level can monitor the price variation on weekly as well as monthly basis in 17 major cities of the country. Ranking is based on a basket of 10-12 essential items whose prices differential is calculated among DC rates and PBS prices through weighted average.


Province Ranks (08-Jul-2021)


City Ranks - Essential Items (08-Jul-2021)

IV. OVERALL ANALYSIS (08-JUL-2021)

- 7 Cities retained the position, 2 cities improved while 8 cities declined in ranking this week as compared to previous week
- Difference between top and last is 82.69 points this week while for the last week the difference was 85.01 points

V. CITYWISE ANALYSIS (08-JUL-2021 OVER 01-JUL-2021)

- Sukkur has retained 1st position with decrease in differential of 0.27 points from 5.78 to 5.51 points
- Khuzdar has retained 2nd position with increase in differential of 1.79 points from 7.57 to 9.36 points
- Bannu has retained 3rd position with increase in differential of 3.62 points from 11.91 to 15.53 points
