Subject: Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) for the week ended on 20-06-2019.

11. A review of the current average prices of Cement collected for the week ended on 20.06.2019 shows an increase of 1.54% over previous week and an increase of 3.07% over corresponding week of the last year. Average retail prices of Fertilizers and Cement are given at Appendix-B.
