Pakistan Social and Living Standards Measurement Survey (PSLM), 2010-11 is the sixth round of a series of surveys planned to be conducted up to 2015. The survey has been conducted with the aim to provide data for use by the government to monitor development plans at district level and rapid assessment of programmes initiated under Medium Term Development Framework (MTDF) in the overall context of MDGs.

The survey has been conducted covering 76,546 households to provide indicators in the sectors such as Education, Health, Water Supply & Sanitation and Household Economic Situation & Satisfaction by facilities and services use. The fieldwork was carried out between July 2010 and June 2011. This report provides information on the key social indicators at district level with urban/ rural breakdown.

The report contains five chapters.
