EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

SENSITIVE PRICE INDICATOR (SPI) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 06.11.2025.

(To gauge inflation on weekly / short term basis)

Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) is computed on weekly basis to assess the price movement of essential commodities at shorter interval of time so as to review the price situation in the country. SPI comprises of 51 essential items collected from 50 markets in 17 cities of the country.

I. ANALYSIS OF WEEKLY SPI

- i.* The SPI for the current week ended on **November 06, 2025 decreased** by **0.59%**. Major **decrease** is observed in the prices of Tomatoes (37.93%), Onions (4.88%), Garlic (3.23%), Pulse Gram (1.58%), Chicken (0.68%), Sugar (0.64%), Gur (0.60%), Pulse Masoor (0.55%) and LPG (0.15%).
 - ii.* On the other hand, major **increase** is observed in the prices of Eggs (2.40%), Bananas (2.32%), Firewood (1.61%), Diesel (1.12%), Beef (0.93%), Tea Prepared (0.92%), Petrol (0.91%), Bread (0.55%), Wheat Flour (0.34%), Powdered Milk (0.31%) and Cooking Oil 5 Litre (0.21%).
 - iii.* During the week, out of **51** items, prices of **18** (35.29%) items increased, **12** (23.53%) items decreased and **21** (41.18%) items remained stable.
- II.** The year on year trend depicts **increase** of **4.18%**. Major **increase** is observed in the prices of Ladies Sandal (55.62%), Sugar (43.67%), Gas Charges for Q1 (29.85%), Wheat Flour (19.50%), Gur (18.88%), Firewood (14.25%), Beef (14.09%), Vegetable Ghee 2.5 Kg (11.53%), Onions (11.22%), Vegetable Ghee 1 Kg (9.79%) and Diesel (9.29%), while **decrease** is observed in the prices of Garlic (33.54%), Pulse Gram (29.82%), Electricity Charges for Q1 (26.26%), Potatoes (22.32%), Tomatoes (19.69%), Tea Lipton (17.79%), Pulse Mash (15.52%), Chicken (15.16%), LPG (9.14%) and Pulse Masoor (4.95%).

III. Current week over previous week (WoW) (06.11.2025 over 30.10.2025) showing -0.59% change.
